PTA Update: Thomas Jensen said the Red Ribbon Week was off to a great start. Kids loved the Crazy Hair
day yesterday. The book fair is doing well and includes prepaid book orders. The PTA worked to organize
and distribute class t-shirts to all the students today.

Budget Adjustments After including the requests, our unallocated amount would be \$9993.93. For the
Science Fair, \$288 was submitted but recommended \$600 for proposed tri-fold boards plus additional
budget for awards and appreciation was allotted. The teacher grants to be used for classroom
purchases to promote reading math science or social/emotional learning was to be a maximum of \$7500
or approximately \$350 per teacher. This information will be presented at JSSC this Friday to get the
grants going. Also, \$2500 is set aside for the school reading club where all grades will read a book
together at home in families. We will ask how to make it relevant and maybe have people submit
pictures and create a book worm with dots along the front wall/hall.

Stefanne motioned to approve the budget. Annikka Seconded the motion.
