

# Site Council Minutes

A. Call To Order: Meeting was called to order at 5:39pm. Ms. Spicer, Ms. Hill, Mrs. Tassin, and Dr. Contreras attended. Mr. James and Ms. Cardona were not present.

B. Approval of Minutes- Minutes from 9/27/22 were approved by all members present

### C. Agenda Items

#### 1. Tax Credit - Review Budget

- a. Ms. Hill questioned the flow of funds since fewer teachers are involved in clubs.
- b. Ms. Spicer asked for the amount of money that comes out of the fund for referees. Money will come out of M&O or Tax Credit.
- c. Ms. Hill asked about community-based sponsorships for schools.  
Wigwam Creek currently has a community-based sponsorship with Hacienda del Rey, a partnership with Fry's, and funds from the campus vending machine
- d. Members discussed additional sources of funds, such as AmazonSmile
- e. Ms. Spicer asked if the campus can charge a nominal fee for sporting events to raise funds in the event we don't have funding from the Tax Credit. Mrs. Tassin will take this question to district staff.
- f. Ms. Hill asked if the student council can fundraise to pay for referees. Student council funds can only be used for student needs/events, not to pay staff members.
- g. Nothing to vote on currently for the Tax Credit

### D. Informational Items

1. Curriculum - Reading books in classrooms

- a. Ms. Spicer presented questions about the books that are incorporated in the English/Language Arts and Reading curriculum. Wigwam Creek will present a novel per quarter (starting quarters 3 & 4) that is linked to our current curriculum on StudySync. Mrs. Tassin will share de identified data on reading scores to Ms. Spicer.
- 2. HB 2495 Update - How does this impact student access to books?
  - a. A parent permission form will be created and sent home when a student wants to check-out a book that meets the criteria for prohibited by HB 2495.
- 3. Safety Symposium: Being held next Wednesday, 12/7/22. Open House from 5:30-6:00 then a presentation from 6:00 - 7:30 in the Wigwam Creek Middle School cafeteria.
- 4. Winter Festival: Tentative date is 12/15/22.
