Re: Asbestos



This system is in compliance with all AHERA regulations pertaining to asbestos bearing material on these campuses.

Asbestos only presents a health hazard when fibers become airborne and are inhaled. The mere presence of asbestos containing material does not present a health hazard.

Pursuant to the 1989 ASBESTOS HAZARD EMERGENCY RESPONSE ACT, the Lawrence County School System has:

*Completed periodic surveillance of identified asbestos containing material every 6 months.

The results of the reinspection report and the management plan are on file in the Principal's office of each school and the county Maintenance Department. They are also available for viewing any time during normal school hours. The program manager, Mr. Adam Daniel, is available to answer any questions that you may have about asbestos in our buildings.
