Welcome to our summer reading program!

Use this packet to help you keep track of your reading this summer. Everyone should read at least five books, and we challenge you to read at least 30 minutes every day. We encourage you to use Beanstack to keep track of your reading; however, a paper tracker is included in the packet as an alternative. Reading independently, reading aloud, being read to and audio books all count when logging minutes. A recommended reading list is attached. These titles are merely suggestions; feel free to read whatever you want. Just read! Rising fourth and fifth graders have required reading that will count toward one of the five books: *Matilda* or *The BFG* by Roald Dahl for fourth graders, and *From the Mixed-Up Files of Mrs. Basil E. Frankweiler* for fifth graders. In an effort to strengthen our reading community, we are initiating a new program: One School One Book. Every student will receive a copy of *Stuart Little* that they will take home and read with their family. When school resumes, we all will have much to discuss, and we can celebrate our reading as a school!

Rising fourth graders: 3 books

+*Matilda* or *The BFG* by Roald Dahl

Rising fifth graders: 3 books

Beanstack

Take advantage of our subscription to Beanstack. Beanstack is an app that makes reading fun! Participate in reading challenges, log your reading, watch your statistics grow, see which friends are on the leaderboard, create a reading streak and more. We encourage the use of Beanstack; however, a paper log is included in the packet as an alternative. Flip the page for directions for getting started on Beanstack.

In the App

To download the Beanstack app, visit the Apple App Store or Google Play Store and search for 'Beanstack'. Once you're in the app, simply search for your school and login using your Pace Academy Google credentials. Then, follow the steps below to log reading, activities and write reviews.

Click the + in the tab bar



Then

Log Reading

Click "Reading" and choose a way to enter your book title. (Pro tip: scanning the ISBN is the easiest and most fun!)



Click "Start Timer" to automatically time your reading session or "Log Reading" to enter the date, minutes read, and other details. Click "Done" to enter your log.

Click "Activity," choose an activity badge and then an activity. Follow the instructions to complete the activity.

Login to your Beanstack account with your Pace Academy Google credentials. Then, follow the steps below to log reading, activities and write reviews.

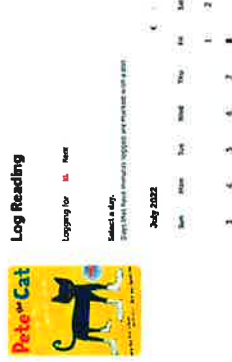
Your district and school add new challenges throughout the year, so make sure to check your "Challenges" tab to register for any new challenges!

Select "Minutes" and fill in the date, minutes, title, and author. Click the book completion toggle to "Finished" if you completed the book. Then click "Log."

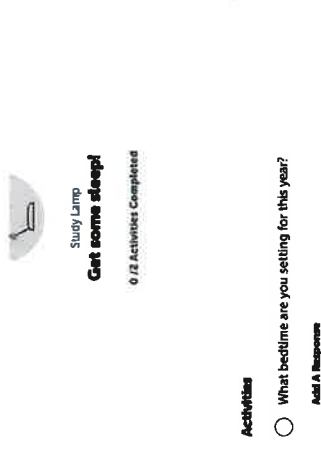


Log an Activity

Select "Activities," choose an activity badge and then an activity. Follow the instructions to complete the activity.



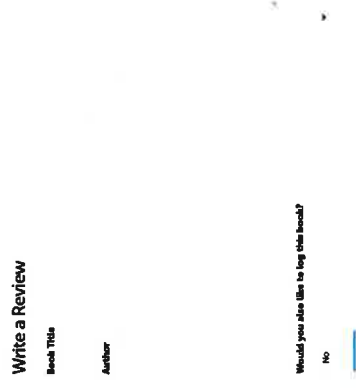
If you earned a badge, you'll see it right away! Check out your progress toward your next badge under the "Logging Badges" tab.
