APPLICATION FOR FACILITIES USE FROM PICKLERIGHT LLC (SUNDAY REQUEST)

STRASBURG ELEMENTARY COMMUNICATION

Mr. Stoltzfus presented a letter from Strasburg resident, John Johnson, regarding concerns with Strasburg Elementary upkeep. Weeds have since been cut down, cleaned up and sprayed. Video surveillance signs have been posted and the cracks do not appear to cause an immediate safety concern. Mr. Stoltzfus talked directly to Mr. Johnson and Mr. Johnson thanked the District for addressing the concerns.

MARTIN MEYLIN MIDDLE SCHOOL RENOVATIONS DESIGN UPDATE

Crabtree Rohrbaugh Architects (CRA) have been working with Mrs. Kowitz and her building to review plans. CRA will also have several consultants in once school is out conducting surveys.

EARLY CHILDHOOD CENTER AND CRITICAL CAPITAL PROJECTS UPDATE

Mr. Davis and Mr. Stoltzfus updated the Committee on the projects and plans for the summer. There will be much activity this summer including windows, sidewalks, roofing, and boilers. Several change orders remain in review including ground water drainage at the Early Childhood Center.

CAMPUS AND BUILDING UPDATES

Mr. Davis provided an update on the track lighting. He has obtained 2 of 3 requested quotes and will bring these back for further consideration in the near future.
