

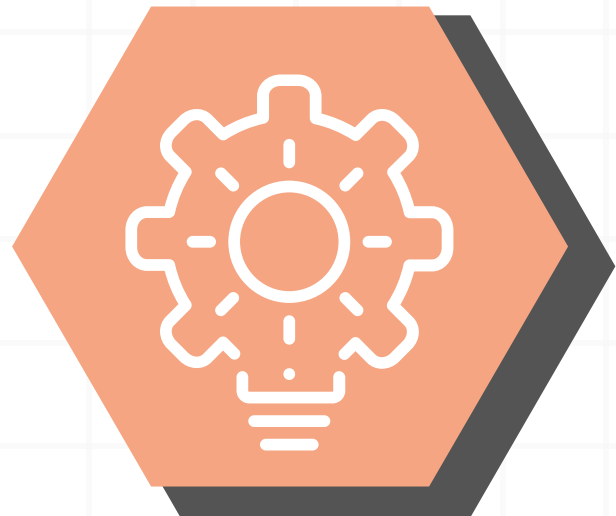


What is ACT Now?

- Set of proactive measures to address the safety, security and well-being of students
- Focus: whole school community

How Does It Work?

- Awareness and prevention
- Internal systems and protocols
- Physical and emotional safety of students
- Enhanced safety of school facilities



Overarching Goals

- Provide awareness, training, support, and procedures to prevent threats to student safety and well being
- Identify and properly report when initial grooming behavior is suspected, professional boundaries are crossed, or student/employee conduct is in violation of our policies
- Continue to review and analysis of safety systems and protocols to enhance areas of vulnerabilities

Staff Trainings & Support

- Staff development on identifying child grooming behaviors
- Yearly mandated reporting trainings
- Additional monthly micro trainings for school site staff

Academic Case Carrier Support

- Support and mentor to all foster and homeless youth through Academic Case Carriers

Security Systems & Equipment

- Raptor Management System
- Single-points of entry during school hours, and supervised points of entry and exit during student arrival and dismissal times
- Security cameras
- Secured campus perimeters

School Site Protocols

- Student Hall Pass Protocols
- Daily Campus Monitoring and Logging Protocols



Additional Staff & Support

- School Resource Officers (SROs)
- School Counselors and mental health support staff
- District Crisis Response team



Community & Partnerships

- Safety Committees at each school site consisting of Administration, Staff, Parents and Students
- Utilize local community organizations to provide services, resources and support to students and families
- Contract with child sexual abuse prevention consultant
- Schedule community forums to provide parent education and safety protocols



Classroom Assessments

- Classrooms or spaces that are isolated or outside fields of vision
- Capital projects to reconfigure offices and classrooms to address physical or structural vulnerabilities to safety
