- ✓ Consistently receive effective evaluations and/or recommendations from current GOLCS supervisor.
- ✓ Demonstrate relentless work ethic and commitment to students
- Display track record of consistently implementing professional feedback
- ✓ Possess strong knowledge of desired content area(s) and ability to meet minimum number of credits required for certification
