
# **HEDGEHOG HANNAH**

# SUMMER CHALLENGES REGISTRATION

Registration begins online at 12:01 AM on *May 30th*. Go to the links on our website at avonlibrary.net to register. The information below will help you pick what reading club is best for adults or which challenges are best for your child.

Click 'register' and fill out the form. Please include an email address and/or phone number so we can contact you if you win a prize. Both adult and children's summer reading this year will be completely done through **Beanstack - you will not need to register for any other platforms.** 

Kids in grades 9-12 can register for EITHER an adult reading club OR Club 512, but not both.

#### CHALLENGES

Logging your reading and completing activity challenges begins *June 5th* at 12:01 AM and ends on *July 21st* at 11:59 PM. You must complete all challenges by this time - no exceptions! Please count only what you read from *June 5th* to *July 21st*.

Children ages 0-6 will track their reading by how many books they have read or have read to them.

Children in 1st-4th grade will track their reading by number of hours they have read/listened to books.

Kids in 5th-12th grade track their reading by number of hours they have read/listened to books.

All groups will have activity challenges they can complete for virtual badges and prizes.

#### **PRIZE PICKUP**

Children's first through third level prizes, challenge prizes, Library Bucks and registration prizes will be given out as earned or you may wait until the end of the program to pick them all up at once. Badges earned are virtual, not physical prizes. All prizes are as supplies last and there may be substitutes (so it is best to pick up your prizes early!). All prizes must be picked up by *July 28th*. Raffles for adult readers will be drawn weekly. *If you have a chain for brag tags from previous years, please reuse it! We have a limited number of chains!*

<b>Club 512</b> For teens and tweens only!	Those entering grades 5-12 this fall Grades 9-12 can choose Club 512 <b>OR</b> an Adult Reading Club	25 library bucks earned for every 5 hours of reading, up to 40 hours. Complete activity challenges for extra bucks!
Adult Reading Clubs Timekeepers & Cliffhangers No children/families	Grades 9-12 and adults 18 & up	Log reading by 500 pages OR 180 minutes read for entry into weekly prize drawings.
