GREEN RUN CAMPUS STUDENT PARKING REGULATIONS

Space is not available for all students to park. No parking is permitted in the driver education lot at any time. The middle lot is reserved for faculty parking only. The Green Run student parking lot is the lot located on the S. Independence Blvd. side of the building nearest Dahlia Drive. **Parking on school grounds is not a right; it is a privilege. Parking permits will be issued in the following priority: 1. Students enrolled in a class that permits early release to work; 2. Students enrolled in another school for a portion of each day; 3. Seniors with permission for early release; 4. Juniors in good academic/discipline standing.** Remaining permits will be issued based upon good standing in school and order of receipt of application.

1. All automobiles parked on school grounds must be registered with the school and must **display the current parking sticker on the left rear window**. Parking stickers must be properly displayed at all times or the car will be subject to ticketing, booting, or towing. Stickers are valid only for the car registered and only for the student to whom it was issued.
2. Student parking is strictly limited to the student parking lot only. Faculty, staff, and service vehicle parking is marked accordingly and is off limits to students.
3. To facilitate identification, automobiles are to be parked front end first in the parking space. Vehicles parked incorrectly may be subject to ticketing.
4. All vehicles must be licensed and covered by insurance. The school is not responsible for the automobile or its contents.
5. There is to be no loitering or visitation in the parking lot.
6. Smoking regulations apply to the parking lot as they do to the entire school premises. "NO SMOKING!"
7. Drivers must observe the posted speed limit of 10 miles per hour and traffic patterns. No vehicles are allowed to exit through the one-way entrance from Dahlia Drive. Reckless driving and endangerment will result in loss of parking privileges.
8. Student vehicles may be subject to search if there are reasonable grounds to believe that drugs, alcohol, stolen property, weapons, or other contraband might be present in the vehicle.
9. Parking regulations are strictly enforced. Suspension of driving privileges, ticketing, booting, towing, and/or suspension from school may occur as a result of any violation of these regulations.
10. Stickers are non-transferable and must be permanently attached. Stickers may not be taped to the window. If you need a replacement sticker for any acceptable reason (i.e. vehicle was wrecked, sold, traded, etc.) you must bring the original sticker to the Student Activities Office. You will not be issued a replacement sticker unless the original is returned. The replacement fee is \$3.00.
11. Any sticker found attached to a vehicle for which it was not issued will be revoked, and the vehicle will be booted or towed at the owner's expense.
12. Absence or tardiness to school due to accidents or breakdowns is inexcusable.
13. Failure to display a current parking sticker or violation of any of the above rules will result in one of the following actions:
 - a. **1st Violation-** Warning ticket/sticker
 - b. **2nd Violation-** Warning ticket/sticker
 - c. **3rd Violation-** Booting or Towing/fine**NOTE:** Any car towed from the GRHS parking lot is subject to the rules, fines, and regulations of the company that is contracted to tow the car. GRHS does not assume any responsibility for the car once it has been towed.

I have read and understand the parking regulations listed above. I understand that violation of these rules may result in the loss of driving privileges, suspension from school, booting, or towing. Applications containing false information will result in the denial of parking privileges for the school year. I also understand that being issued a parking sticker provides me with permission to park the vehicle if space is available and that I am not guaranteed a parking space.
