

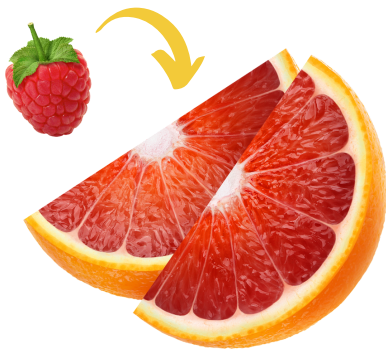


# BLOOD ORANGE
