

LEGAL NOTICE
TOWN OF SUFFIELD
WATER POLLUTION CONTROL AUTHORITY

Notice is hereby given that the Water Pollution Control Authority of the Town of Suffield Connecticut held its Public Hearing at the Water Pollution Treatment Facility, 844 East St. South, in Suffield Connecticut on Tuesday, May 16, 2023 at 7:00 p.m. and has set the sewer use fees as follows:

Sewer Use Fee for Residential and Equivalent Units, and the rate per 1,000 gallons in excess of 46,000 gallons per year. The schedule of Sewer Use Fees for Fiscal Year 2023-2024 is as follows:

Residential and Equivalent Units:	\$380.00
Rate per thousand gallons in excess of 46,000 gallons per year.	\$9.09

Kent Farms Community Sewerage System rates were NOT APPROVED and a revised proposal will be posted May 18, 2023.

All Sewer User Fees are due and payable on July 1, 2023. Failure to pay the annual Sewer User Fee on or before August 1, 2023 will render the bill delinquent from July 1, 2023 at the rate of one and one-half (1 ½%) percent per month or any portion of a month or eighteen (18) percent per annum in accordance with the provisions of C.G.S. Sec. 12-146. Sewer use payments should be payable to "Town of Suffield, WPCA" and may be mailed or made in person at The Tax Collector's Office, Town Hall, 83 Mountain Road, Suffield CT 06078 and will be open for collection from 8:00AM to 4:30 PM Monday through Thursday, and 8:00AM to 1:00PM on Fridays.

Any person aggrieved by any charge for the use of the sewerage system may make written appeal to the Town of Suffield, WPCA, 844 East Street South, Suffield, CT 06078, within twenty-one days after May 17, 2023, which is the date such charge is filed with the Suffield Town Clerk pursuant to Section 7-255(a) of the Connecticut General Statutes, requesting a review of the user charge.
