### Pattern of School Year

Two 18-week semesters  
.50 credit per class per semester  
7 periods a day-50 minute class length

### Testing Program

SAT/ACT- interested juniors and seniors  
ASVAB- juniors (when requested)  
Smarter Balanced- (Oregon Statewide Assessment) all juniors (not during 20-21 year)  
AP Class Assessments- interested students, grades 10-12

### Class Rank

Students are ranked numerically according to grade point average. All courses with a letter grade A-F are included. No courses are weighted. The total class enrollment is included in computing class rank.

### Marking System

A, B, C, D, F, PASS (P), NO PASS (NP), I (INCOMPLETE)- student has nine weeks to complete the work or the I becomes an F, issued for medical reasons or during 20-21 school year.

N (NO CREDIT)

G (NO GRADE)

Credit by Recovery- students receiving a grade between 55%-59% can make up work in certain classes, by teacher approval only, to receive credit. The F is replaced with the passing grade.

Students may retake a course if they received an F. The F changes to a G on the transcript; the student receives a new grade A-D or Pass if proficiency standards are met.

**Curriculum Features:**

**Advanced Placement and Honors** opportunities are available in Literature, US History, Calculus, and Psychology. College credit is available through **Willamette Promise** and **College Credit Now** a placement test is required to enroll in certain courses. Students in Willamette Promise (WP) only earn credit if proficiency standards set by the college are met. Students in College Credit Now (CCN) follow the requirements and syllabus of the issuing institution. Students can earn college credit for the following courses:

**Independent Study** classes are available to Stayton students, by administrative and teacher approval.

**Vocational Programs** are available to students in the areas of Business, Agriculture, Biomedical, Education, Emergency & Public Service, STEM, and Manufacturing/Construction.

A **Credit Recovery program** is available on campus during the school day. Students work online to regain credit one class at a time, while supervised by an assigned instructor. Additional **Alternative Education programs, Options Academy, Locust Street Academy, and Winema/Roberts at CCC**, are also available within the North Santiam School District. These students are off campus and are monitored by the counseling office.

**Early college** high school allows students to attend college classes at Chemeketa Community College, while earning dual credit for the courses towards high school graduation requirements.

Students may graduate with **Honor Diploma** if they meet the following criteria, awarded after 7<sup>th</sup> semester:

1. Have ten credits of classes designated college preparation or advanced placement
2. Take a Writing/Literature class each term in high school
3. Take a minimum of five graded classes each semester
4. Have a cumulative GPA of 3.50 after seven semesters
5. Attend school for eight semesters
