Advertising Income Update

- Sports Programs and Calendars - Put on hold for Spring because of COVID-19
 - Will need a plan for Winter.
 - Waiting to hear about whether there will be Fall sports
 - Proposed seasons as follows:
 - Winter- Jan & Feb
 - Fall - March & April
 - Spring - May & June
 - Reduced seasons to 7 weeks with the last week of every season being a culminating week.
 - Likely no non-league games. May be regrouped due to regions.

- Kids and coaches will continue to practice following current restrictions
- Proposal to take official an school break with sports Sept 14th-27th
- Soccer
 - Considered a minimal contact sport.
 - Games may be played with student athletes wearing masks.
- Goal is to keep kids and coaches safe.
- Dance and cheer are considered activities.
 - May start practicing on 9/28. Two times a week.
- New Coaches
 - Skip Collins - new girls soccer coach
 - Bill Baxter - new girls Softball coach
 - Ruth Palfenier - new volleyball coach
 - April Herman - new dance coach
- Boys basketball
 - Maximum of 10 athletes allowed to gather
- Possible financial hardships for teams
- Coaching
 - Head coaching stipends guaranteed as they are working with students
 - Assistant coaches not guaranteed at this time, will re-evaluate in Nov. when we find out if there will be a sports season
- In person physicals for student athletes were cancelled.
 - Advised to contact your healthcare provider.
 - If this is a financial hardship please contact the school to discuss options that may be available.

Sign Sales

- Oregon Health Plan not renewing scoreboard or banner
- Republic Services have made an offer to assist with sign purchase
- They can locally approve \$3000. May be willing to go higher
- No fall sports

- Overhead is about \$5,000
- Scholarships = \$10,000
- PTNW = \$8,300 assuming we have sports.
 - Will be reduced for short seasons
- We need a total of \$23,300 without any projects
- May send a letter asking for donations. Discuss general fund vs special project
- Discussion regarding a new process for coach requests.
 - Coaches go to Darren first then to Boosters.
- 3rd year of being a Nike school
 - \$15-20,000 to spend on Nike products.
 - All varsity teams must wear Nike uniforms for games.
 - Prefer to have coaches in Nike gear as well.

- Fire Hydrant in front of school to be painted
- Records room update for new counselor
 - Removed Cabinets and carpet, painted, and new floor
 - Floor donated by Santiam Valley Interiors
 - Zero cost
- NSSD put all new lights in the gym and on the front of the gym - huge improvement

 - Update State Banners

- Install new Discus throwing Cage - Erin Holm
 - Erin text Randy on 8/17 and will do this as soon as school starts again
- Maintenance Yard Cleanup - Van & Randy
 - Recycle metal - two bins filled, waiting on #3

- Republic Services donated a 20 yard garbage bin. Brian has taken care of this.
- Haul off all old concrete chunks from fence posts and old garage floor
- Recycle old plastic barrels
- Wrestling Room Security - possible gate to be installed
 - Need to move south gate
 - Adding signs “not a play area” (Already purchased, need to hang)
 - Need a barrier idea for center doors - May leave locked with a new camera?
- Photo Class Equipment - Darin Schmidt & Randy
- Consider postponing depending on money
- Rearrange East wall gym bleachers to remove the U from SUHS and create small box
 - Project Date TBD
- Replace eagle logo on home softball dugout with metal sign

New/upcoming projects/tasks/business topics

- Automatic Camera System - \$2,500
 - NFHS video
 - Comes with 2 free camera systems.
 - Pay for installation
 - Likely no or limited spectators
 - Monthly subscription. About \$11/month or \$70/year
 - 5 year lease
 - Upfront cost to be covered
 - Potential revenue for 3 spots for ads
 - All events in the main gym and field would be recorded
 - Questions to be answered
 - i. Can you watch the games at another time than the recording?
