- Sports Program
 - Program is printing tomorrow, need to pick up - Daren to pick up
 - Pick up and get to football ticket booths, Volleyball, and XC
 - Total Sales were \$10,200 (\$9,100 last year) - seller of ad can choose how 50% of that sale goes to, a sports team or boosters. New ads - Up to 100% can be designated by the seller.

- Softball Hitting Facility - Randy and Jeff Silbernagel
 - Work Parties were on 8/24 and 9/14 - Framing is complete
 - Travis King is helping as district support
 - Next work party is Saturday, 9/28, weather dependent, unable to complete if too windy.

Will need to use HS wifi. Discuss power, base will need to be plugged in & connected to wifi. Can check from phone with an app. Able to take a picture of what you see & saves to your phone. Wireless 30, 60 or 90 day recordability. Continuous record.

Price ranges vary. \$250-300 range for a 4-8 camera system. 4 camera system but an 8 camera recorder. Suggest an 8 or 12 camera system as a recording base. 4 (\$250) -8 (\$499).

Consider asking:

How clear do we want the picture to be? Higher quality costs more.

Discuss budget. Do we want to be able to see at night & day.

Motion activated camera. Can set to record 24 hours a day 7 days a week, set to record motion or set to record on consistent motion - ex. Moving for more than 30 seconds. Can record up to 90 seconds past the end of the movement. 15

Color coded alert system, Blue red, blue gray

USB compatible so easy for the police to view if needed.

\$129 at Costco for a cheaper set.

Able to have a notification sent via email or text if movement detected.

Ty suggests an 8 camera system. Frys has one called a Swann link system.

Focal length varies dependent on camera length.

Is the current camera system a closed camera system? If so, we will not be able to gain access to it.
