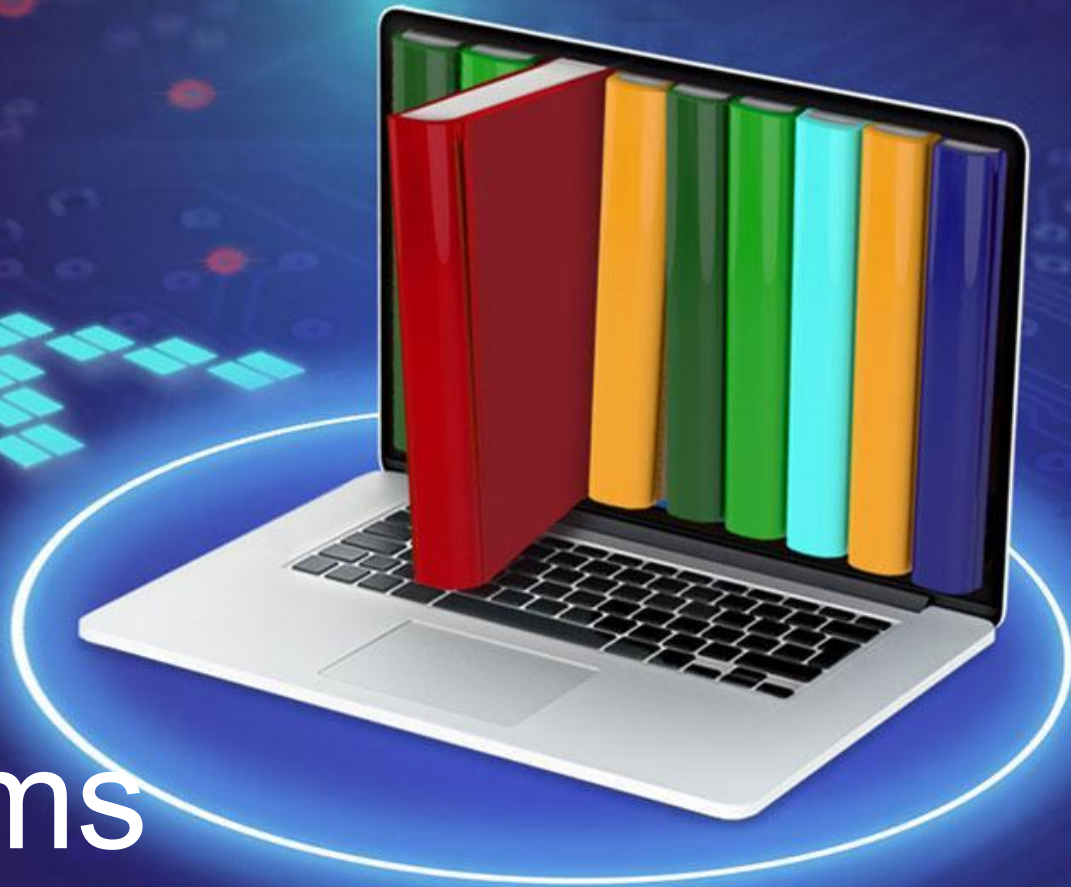


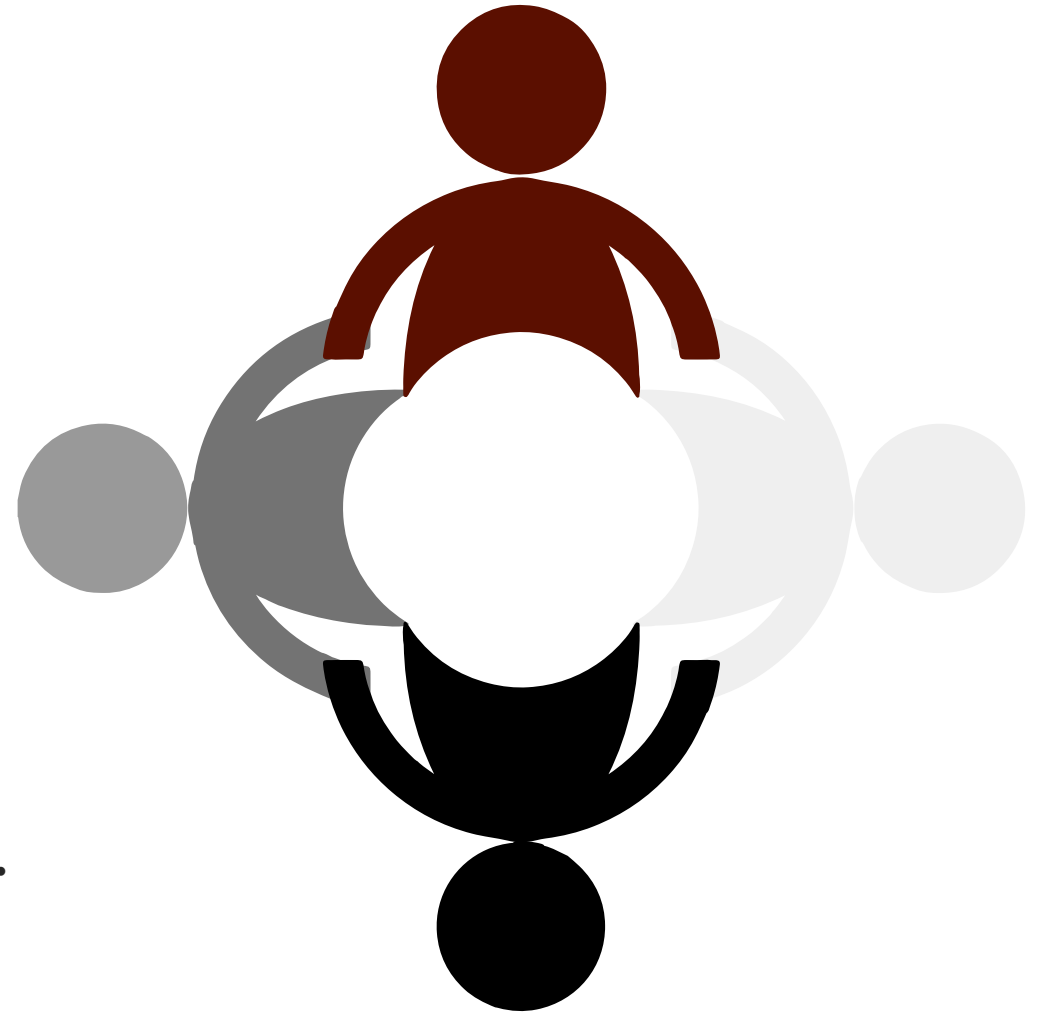
Poteet students never give up and this is why our college programs are a success.
