



Students and Staff: Should You Go to School Today?

Student/Staff has any of the following symptoms
(or has tested positive for COVID-19):

- Fever $\geq 100.4^{\circ}$
- Cough
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- New loss of taste or smell
- Sore throat
- Muscle/body aches
- Fatigue
- Headache
- Congestion and/or runny nose
- Nausea and/or vomiting
- Diarrhea

- If ill with any of these symptoms, please call your health care provider (doctor, NP, PA) or call the NM Department of Health hotline for help at the following number: 1-855-600-3453.
- If you have these symptoms please get tested for COVID-19.
- If you know you have COVID-19, with or without symptoms, please stay home and follow the instructions from NMDOH (isolate at home).
- If you have been a close contact (within 6 feet for ≥ 3 minutes) with someone who has COVID-19 during their infectious period please stay home, get tested.
