CLASS TITLE: SUMMER CAMP STEM COACH

BASIC FUNCTION:

Under the direction of the District Administrator of Expanded Learning, Summer Camp STEM Coach is responsible for working with classroom teachers and instructional assistants to support the expanded learning for 3rd - 6th campers; the STEM Coach will serve as part of a district's ELO-P team to analyze multiple data sources, identify trends, and provide ongoing, differentiated professional learning to support teachers in identifying and reaching goals related to the Expanded Learning Program; the STEM Coach will provide personalized support that is based on the goals and identified needs of the ELO-Program; the STEM Coach will report directly to the Administrator of Expanded Learning Opportunity.

REPRESENTATIVE DUTIES:

ESSENTIAL DUTIES:

Facilitate professional development of teachers through coaching and professional development.

Lead and provide input and feedback on curricular and instructional programming for Summer Camp Expanded Learning.

Support selection and procurement of instructional materials in accordance with the science summer camp.

Demonstrate knowledge of curriculum, subject matter, and principles of adult learning.

Assist with curriculum selection and the development of Expanded Learning curriculum and assessment.

Collaborate with school site leadership in supporting expanded learning opportunities on the elementary campus.

Perform such other tasks and assume such other responsibilities as assigned by the Administrator of Expanded Learning Opportunity.

OTHER DUTIES:

Perform related duties as assigned.

KNOWLEDGE AND ABILITIES:

Record of exceptional professionalism and collaborative communication with all stakeholders.

Commitment to data-driven, student-centered instruction.

Ability to create and maintain positive relationships with teachers and administrators.

EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE:

Any combination equivalent to:

Minimum of 3 years of teaching experience or other instructional leadership experience deemed equivalent.

Experience and expertise in one of the following instructional areas:

- STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics)
- Music/Arts
- Literacy

Indoor/Classroom environment.

PHYSICAL DEMANDS:

Bending at the waist, kneeling or crouching to assist students.

Reaching overhead, above the shoulders and horizontally.

Seeing to read a variety of materials and monitor students.
