

What Is The Student Support Services (SSS) Program?

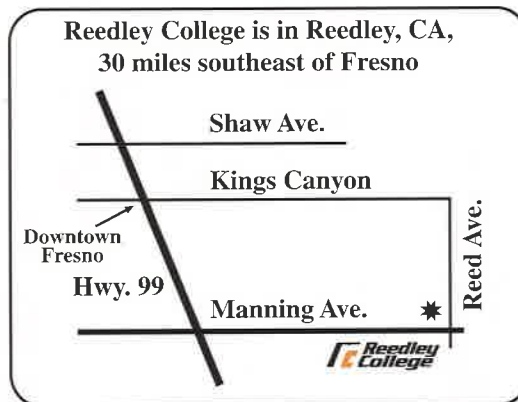

Do You Qualify? (minimum qualifications)

- Yes** I am enrolled at RC in a degree or certificate program
- Yes** I am a U.S. citizen, or permanent resident, or meet residency requirements to receive federal student financial aid
- Yes** I am enrolled full time and in good academic standing (2.0 GPA)
- Yes** I have not completed more than 50 units
- Yes** I am eligible for English 125 and 126 or higher and...
- Yes** One or more of the following apply:
 - I am from a low income family and/or
 - My parent(s)/guardian(s) did not graduate from a four year college and/or
 - I have a disability.
