SCHOOL LINK MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES

*Restoring Hope....
One life at a time.*

Western Mental Health Center's (WMHC) School Linked Mental Health (SLMH) services are designed to co-locate mental health services and resources within the school setting. This allows for minimal disruption from the child's school day. It also allows teachers, parents, and others involved in the child's care the ability to collaborate and integrate successful treatment strategies into the school and home environment.

Referral Process:

Referrals are made by a parent, teacher, social worker or physician.

A Mental Health Professional will complete a Diagnostic Assessment and provide recommendations for services as appropriate.

A parent/guardian will need to be present for the initial Diagnostic Assessment to help provide information on the child and when appropriate for treatment planning.

SLMH staff will coordinate services with the family, school staff, county and other agency professionals involved in the care of the student.
