



Scavenger Hunt Walk

For this activity, you need an adult to go with you outside and the ability to take a walk while staying at least six feet away from anyone you do not live with. This activity cannot be done with ten people or more.

Before you go on a walk, create a scavenger hunt list of things to look for. (examples; Dog, blue car, billboard, tree, wood fence, flowers etc.

Take this list with you, by writing it on a phone, writing it with a writing utensil and a piece of paper or even memorizing it.
(If you are physically writing the list, this is a good time for some extra spelling and handwriting practice)

As you walk, try to compete to see who can find the most items on the list. If you find an item, shout the name of the item before anyone else, and you will earn a point for that item.
