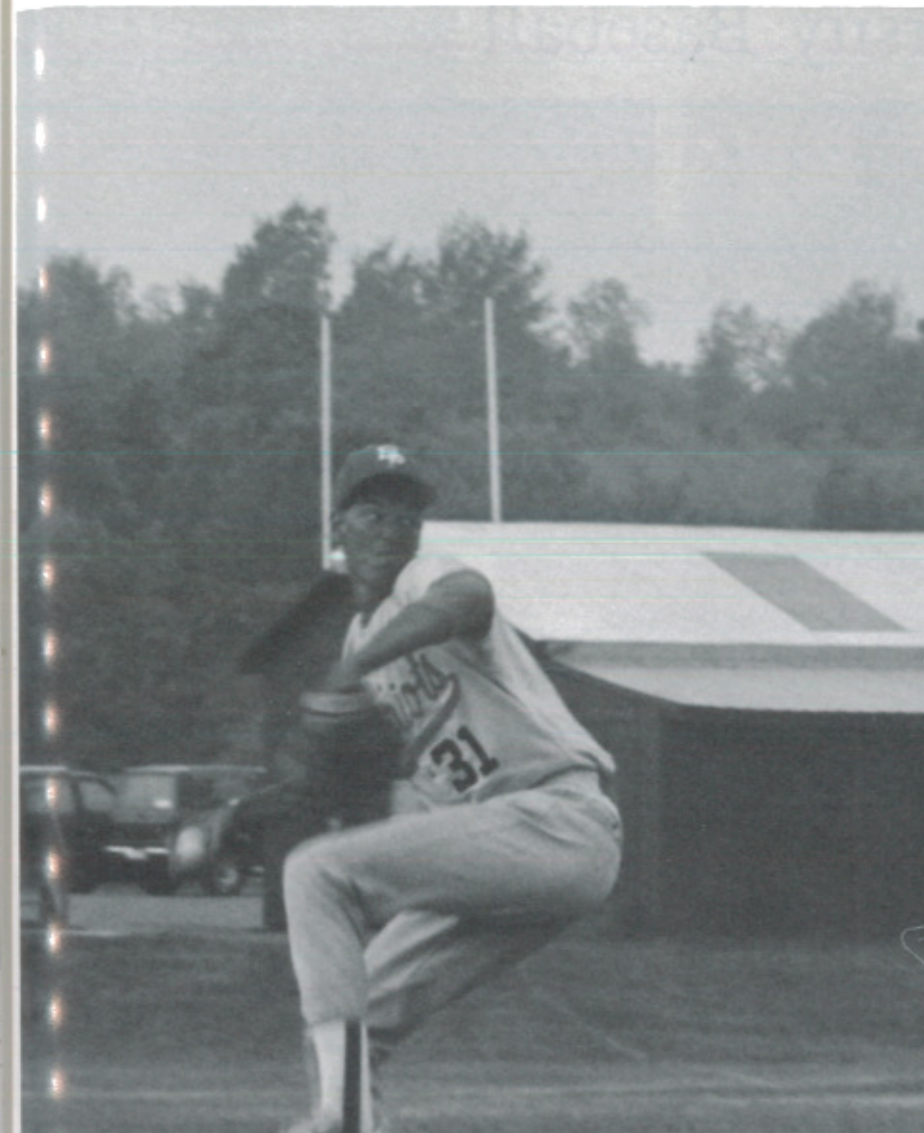
## 1991 Varsity Baseball A Season Like No Other . . .
