Now -of course -EVERYTHING happens on the computer. It has changed the nature of my job. I can't use 80% of my supplies, like clay, acrylic paint, and sculptural materials. It is very sad."

"This year was definitely different than previous years. The past years, I never had to bring a laptop to school; this year I do. I always need to make sure it's charged, so that has been difficult. It's different not being able to do partner work and being able to hug your friends or your teachers. Preparing for this year was definitely different because I didn't need to go out and buy so much paper because it's all online."

"First, because of COVID, I had to drop one of my favorite books: The Crucible. Reading aloud a play isn't feasible this year. Therefore, I had to develop an entirely new unit. I chose a unit on narrative nonfiction and spent Considerable time reading and selecting works. second, COVID forced me to develop my computer skills. I have spent ample time increasing my knowledge of Google Classroom, Seesaw, and Promethean Board technology. Third, although I'm normally organized, I had to improve my organization because I teach in multiple classrooms and don't have complete access to my usual room during the day. Fourth, although I usually eat well and take care of myself, I have to be even more vigilant because health is a priority for all of us now." Mr. Allegretti, English teacher

"The changes COVID brought to senior year is it took away the excitement and normalcy of everyone getting ready, buying what they need to, and ready to hang out with friends the normal way, and some not even able to go in. It gets very lonely and 100% different from the other years for someone who chose to stay home for school. You can't have lunch with your favorite teachers or walk the halls messing around with your friends like before. It's very strict, which it should be, but not normal or what anyone could have expected."

I'm struggling most with finding the motivation to actually do my work and do it well, as well as focusing. Whereas prior to COVID I was doing great in all my classes and had 90+ in the majority of them. One pro I'd say about COVID is that I feel like I have more time to study and prepare for my tests."


"As I prepared for my 18th year at BPHS as a School Counselor, it was a year like no other. We anxiously awaited for guidelines for opening school from the Governor, which did not come until mid August. Mrs. Grimmick and I worked long days to put students in cohorts with common classes. We created a schedule from scratch and hand scheduled every student. Instead of individualizing schedules based on the interests and needs of the students educationally, we prioritized health and minimizing contacts. It was important to retain as much of the schedule, particularly electives, for our students who I felt had lost so much with COVID. As a Counselor, spending less face time with students and more time on my computer has left me feeling disconnected, just as many of my students and families are feeling. Let's hope for a more normal year next year. I have been so impressed with my students' ability to persevere and pivot when they have needed to in these challenging times. I feel like if we can get through this we can get through anything.

I also feel like I have to teach myself more in some ways because in person conversations sometimes bring up other important topics that we don't see or hear through the notes and basically having to look at them and figure out things on your own in some classes, and very helpful videos and online during class meets for others. - **-Zoom shirt:** That one nice shirt you have for your video meetings (All other clothing TBD or optional)


























