

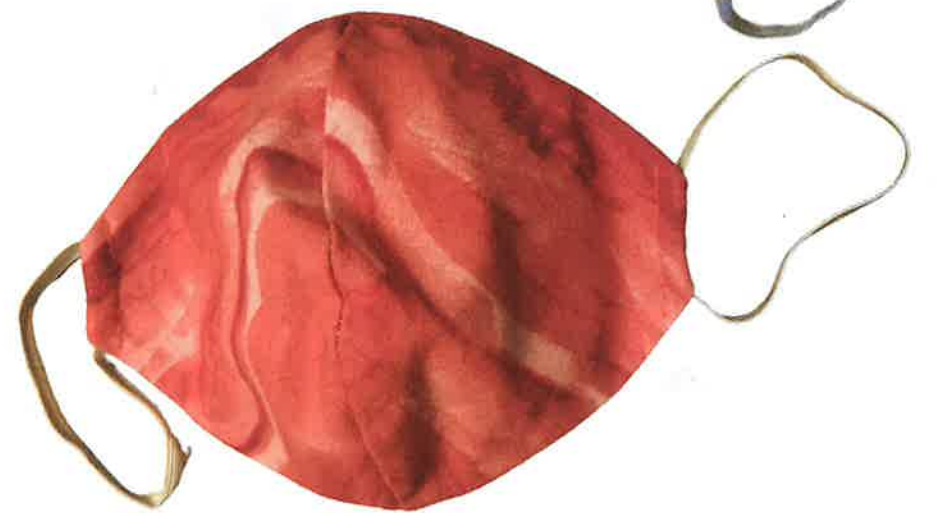

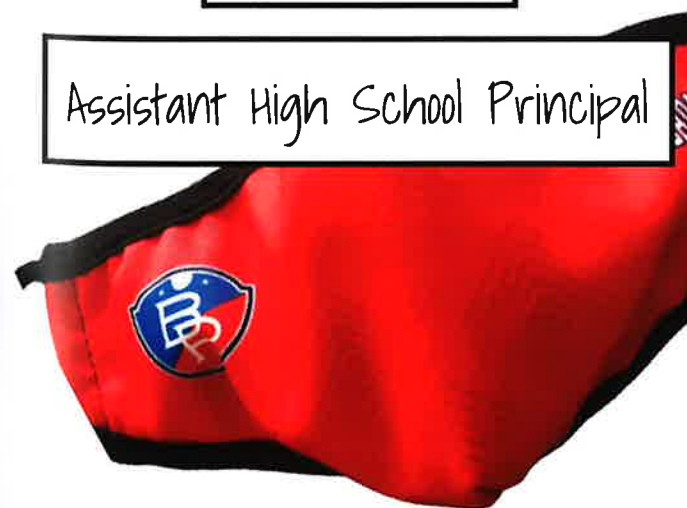

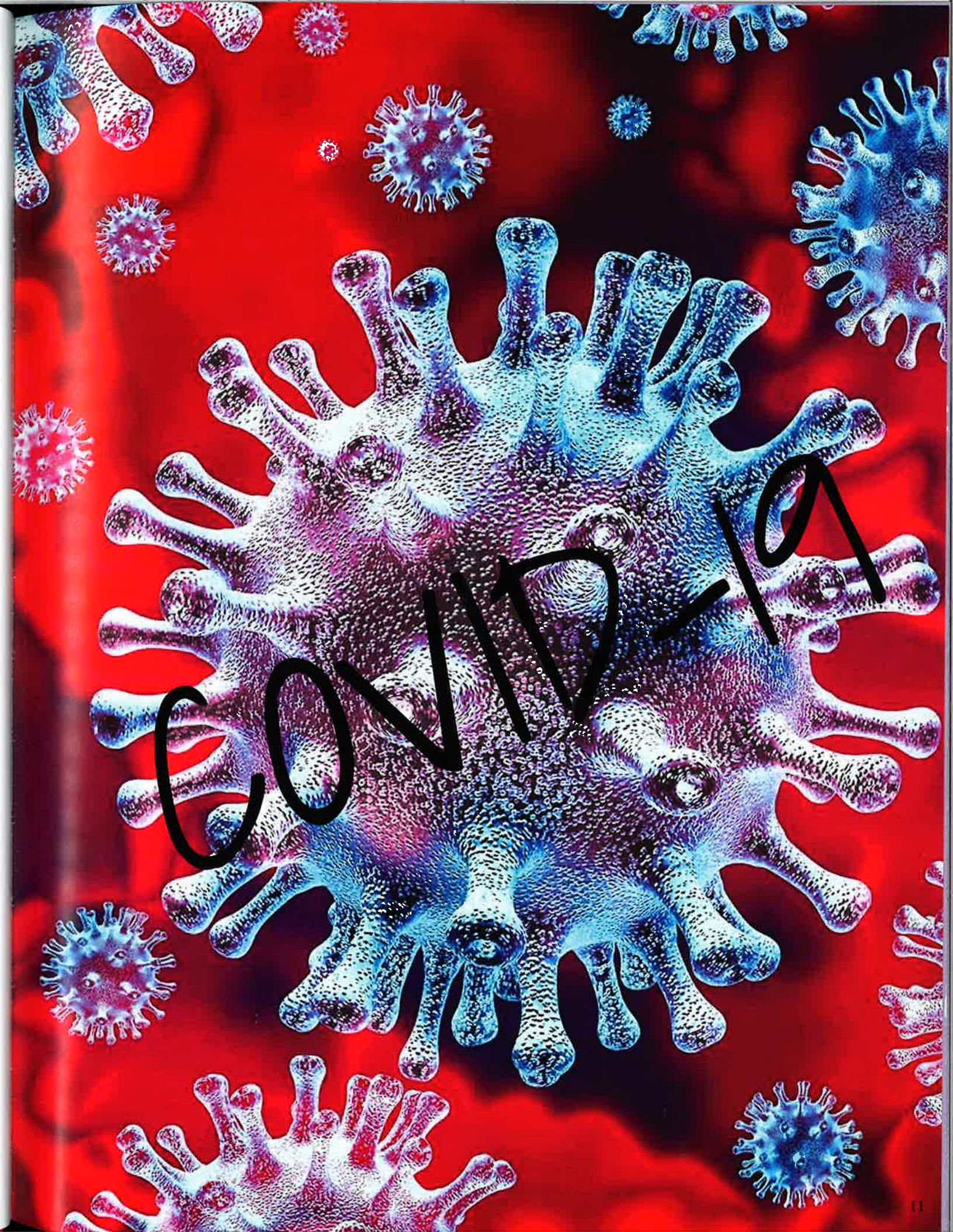

"I had to drastically alter my mindset. Like many teachers, I'm a planner, But I used the time before school started to become more flexible and more open to change in the classroom. Since things are changing day by day, and sometimes minute by minute, my preparation for the school year focused on altering my mindset to become more flexible."

"I feel like this year is so much more complicated with everything, but I only go to BOCES so I wouldn't know how attending Broadalbin would be. But the online work from there hasn't been that bad and I don't mind online work."

"This year was definitely different than previous years. The past years, I never had to bring a laptop to school; this year I do. I always need to make sure it's charged, so that has been difficult. It's different not being able to do partner work and being able to hug your friends or your teachers. Preparing for this year was definitely different because I didn't need to go out and buy so much paper because it's all online."

"The changes COVID brought to senior year is it took away the excitement and normalcy of everyone getting ready, buying what they need to, and ready to hang out with friends the normal way, and some not even able to go in. It gets very lonely and 100% different from the other years for someone who chose to stay home for school. You can't have lunch with your favorite teachers or walk the halls messing around with your friends like before. It's very strict, which it should be, but not normal or what anyone could have expected."

"As an art teacher...Everything is different! Last year before the pandemic the only reason that I used my computer during the school day was to do my attendance, answer emails and write lessons. Now -of course - EVERYTHING happens on the computer. It has changed the nature of my job. I can't use 80% of my supplies, like clay, acrylic paint, and sculptural materials. It is very sad."

"First, because of COVID, I had to drop one of my favorite books: *The Crucible*. Reading aloud a play isn't feasible this year. Therefore, I had to develop an entirely new unit. I chose a unit on narrative nonfiction and spent considerable time reading and selecting works. second, COVID forced me to develop my computer skills. I have spent ample time increasing my knowledge of Google Classroom, Seesaw, and Promethean Board technology. Third, although I'm normally organized, I had to improve my organization because I teach in multiple classrooms and don't have complete access to my usual room during the day. Fourth, although I usually eat well and take care of myself, I have to be even more vigilant because health is a priority for all of us now."

"In a nutshell, everything I do (in order to accommodate both hybrid and remote students) takes much longer....from posting assignments, grading, responding to questions via e-mail instead of in person....the list goes on and on. I and most other teachers are working harder and longer than ever before, just to keep our heads above water, so to speak."

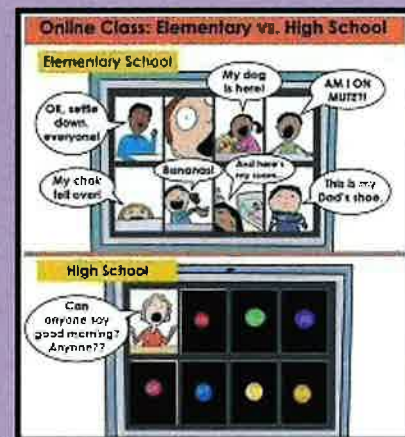
This school year was different because instead of buying binders and paper we bought laptops and chargers. It is weird not coming to school every day and not seeing 200 people in the hallway.

"As I prepared for my 18th year at BPHS as a School Counselor, it was a year like no other. We anxiously awaited for guidelines for opening school from the Governor, which did not come until mid August. Mrs. Grimmick and I worked long days to put students in cohorts with common classes. We created a schedule from scratch and hand scheduled every student. Instead of individualizing schedules based on the interests and needs of the students educationally, we prioritized health and minimizing contacts. It was important to retain as much of the schedule, particularly electives, for our students who I felt had lost so much with COVID. As a Counselor, spending less face time with students and more time on my computer has left me feeling disconnected, just as many of my students and families are feeling. Let's hope for a more normal year next year. I have been so impressed with my students' ability to persevere and pivot when they have needed to in these challenging times. I feel like if we can get through this we can get through anything."

It really depends on the teacher."

Knowing that everything was going to go kind of crazy at some point and just making sure to be in the best situation to adapt as well as I could. I was kind of excited to be in a brand new place, and knew that I was going to have a couple of classes I was really looking forward to teaching. The pandemic actually made things less stressful, because of how crazy everything currently is, it made it easier for me to deal with it and took the stress out of it. Teaching classes this year is different from other years because you see kids half as long as you'd expect, which also makes it difficult to form relationships with the kids. What surprised me is, I learned everyone's names with their eyes. So when kids take their masks off it looks like I'm looking at another class. I hope after all this craziness, it makes things better. I hope this makes me a better teacher, and helps all the students grow and become better students because they're becoming more independent."

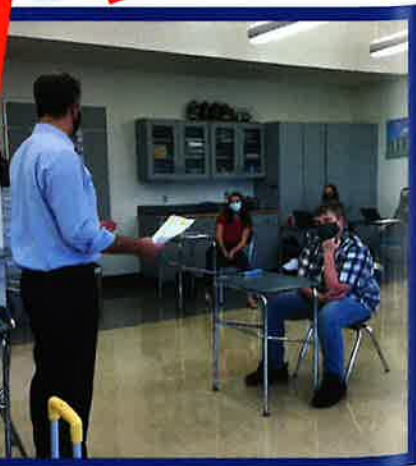
# COVID Dictionary

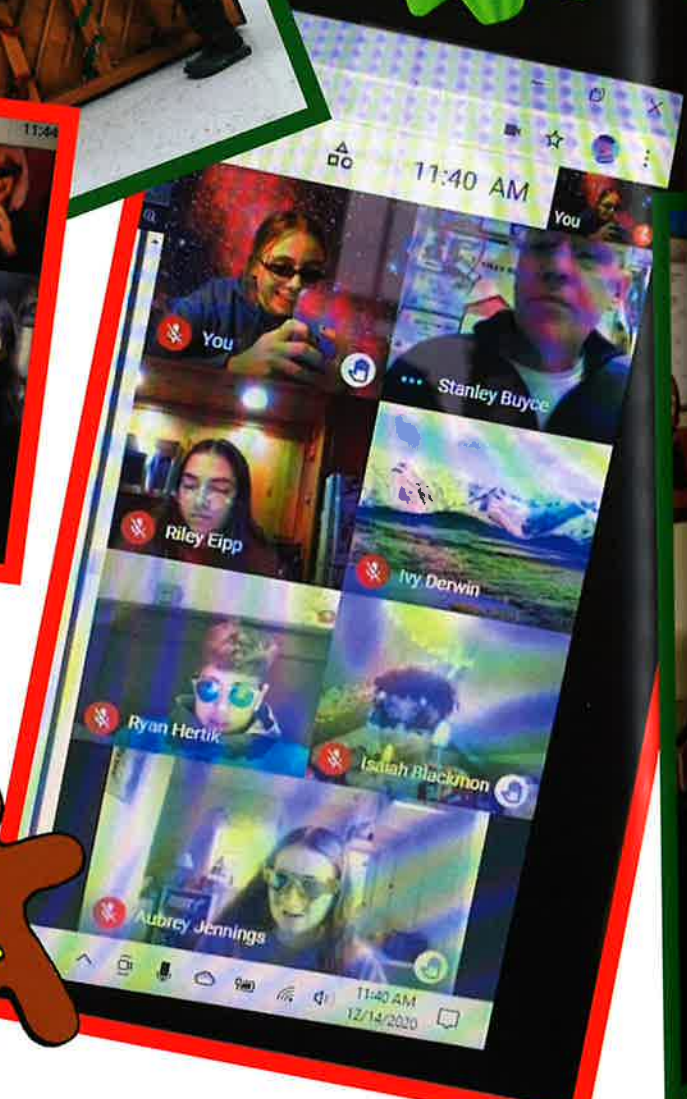








# Holiday Spirit Week
