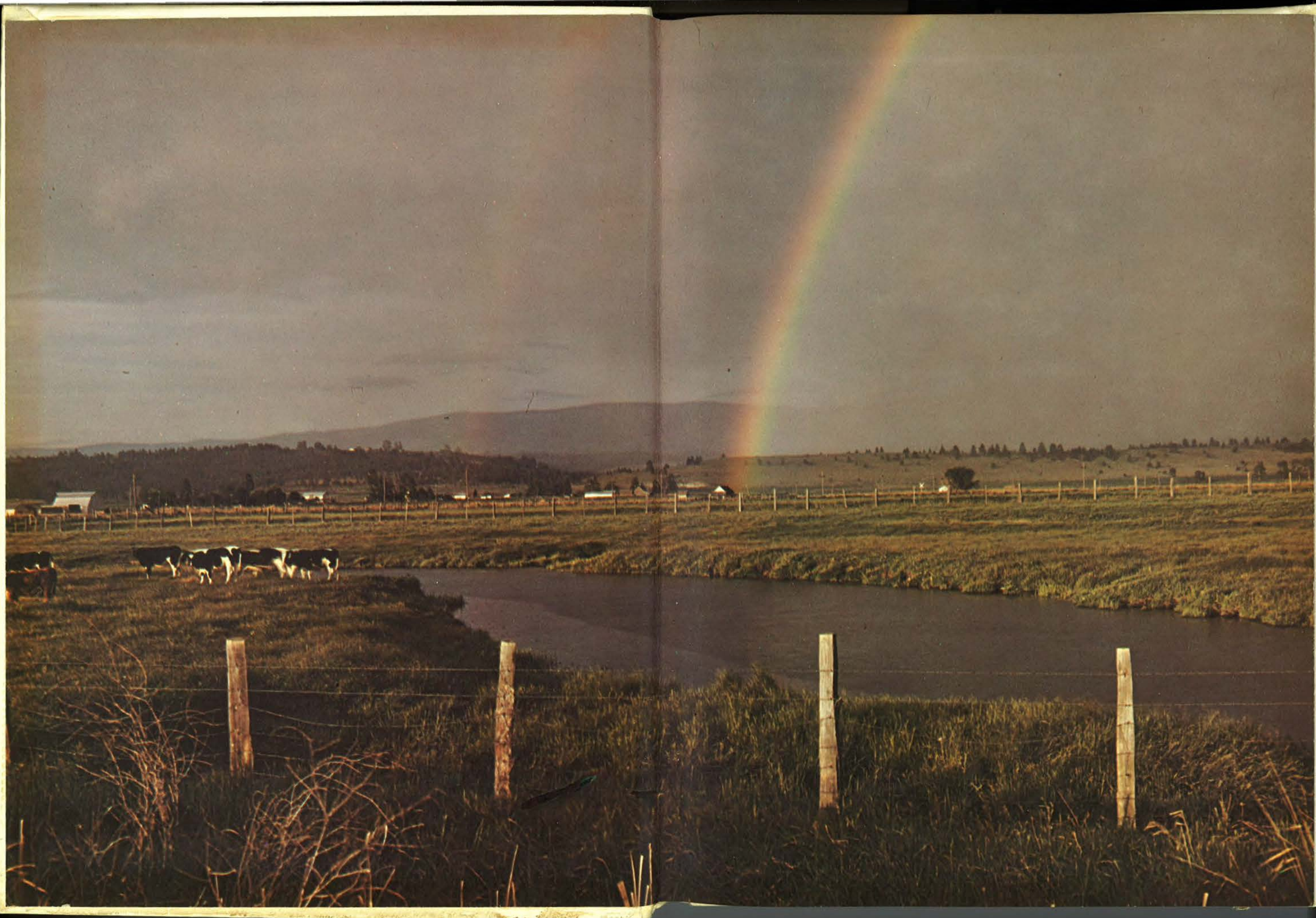

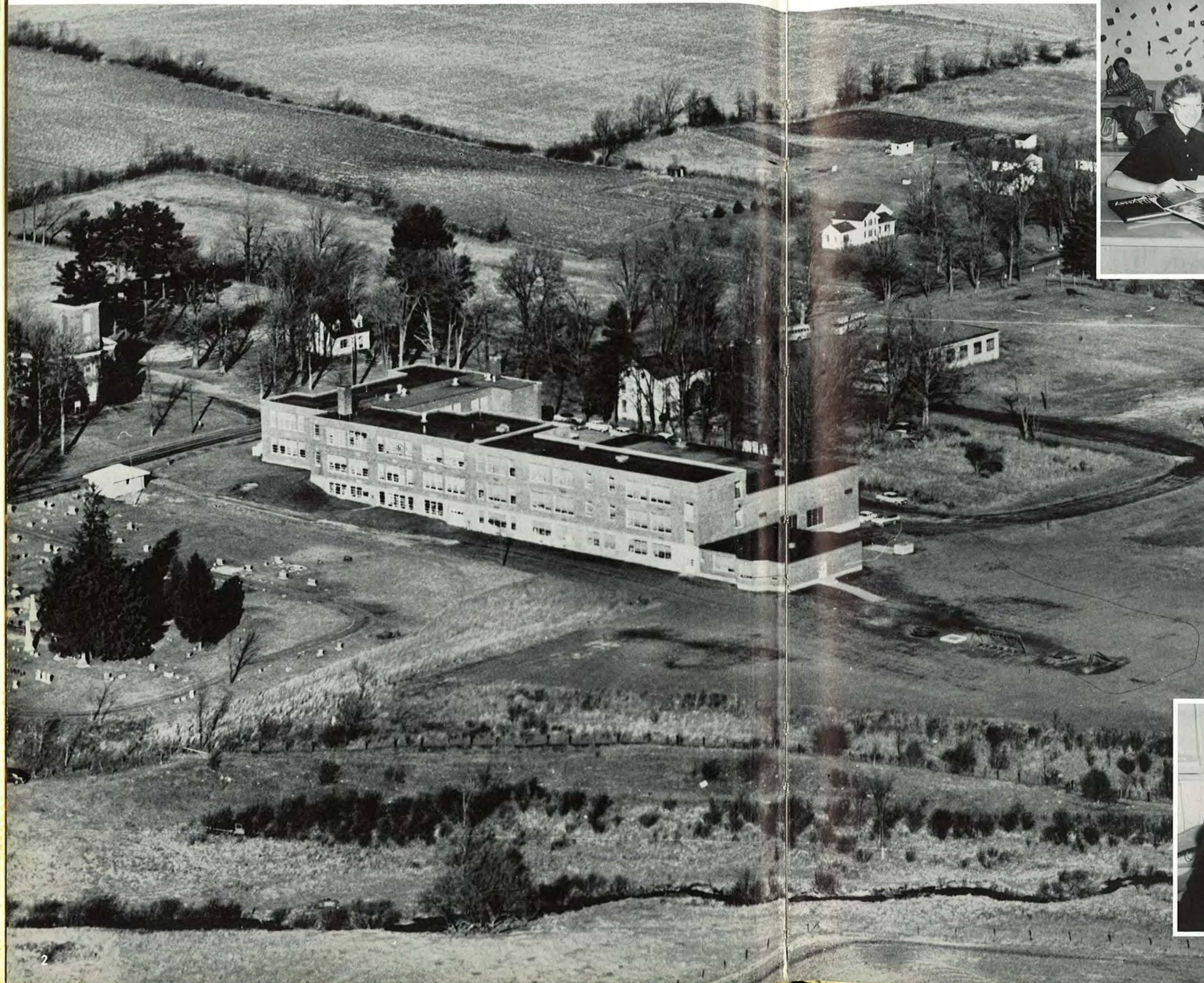

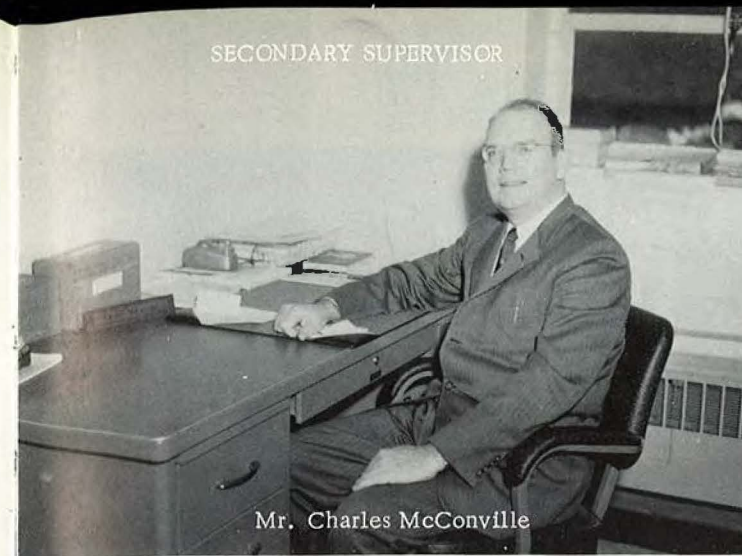
PRINCIPAL'S MESSAGE
