

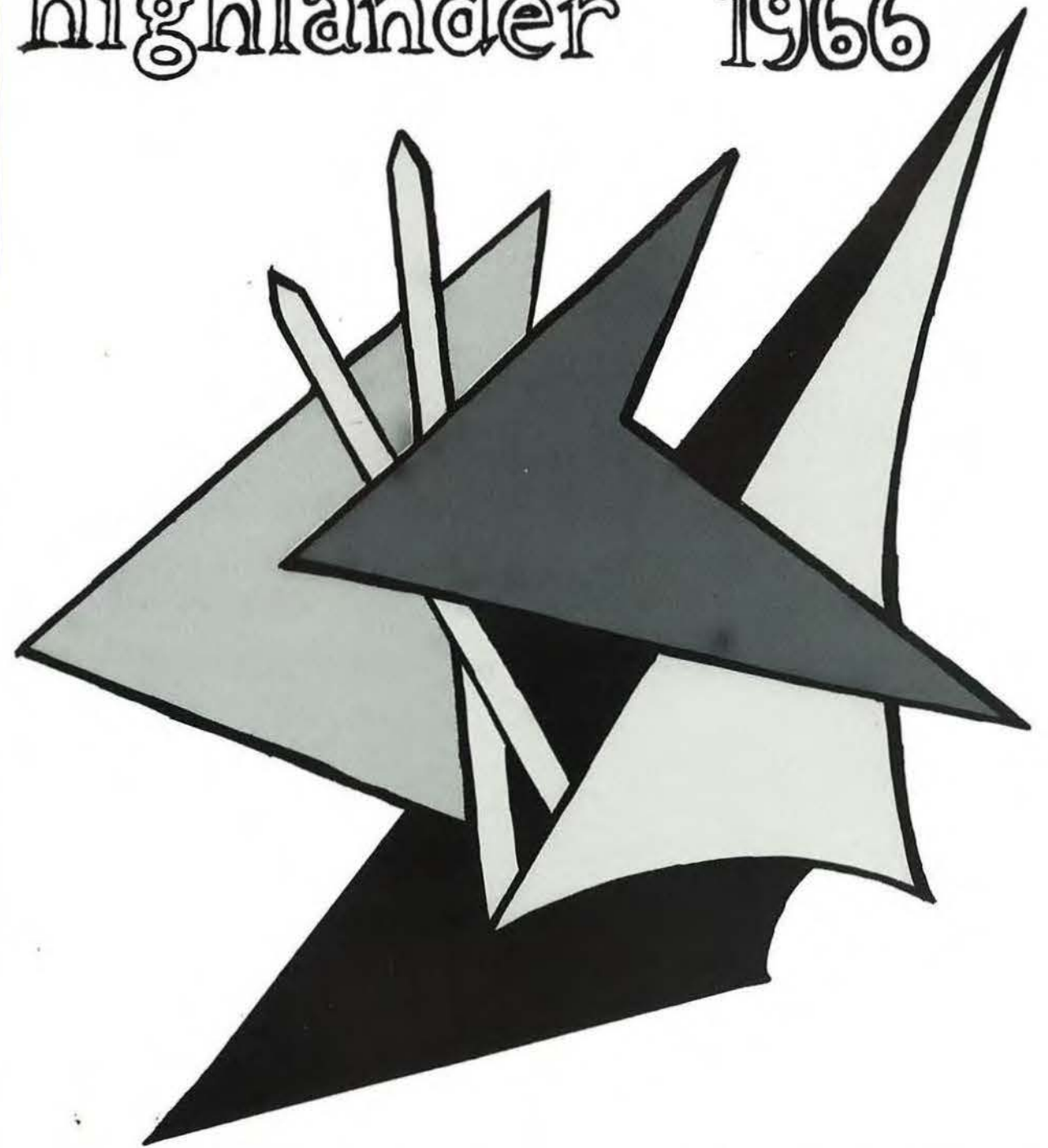

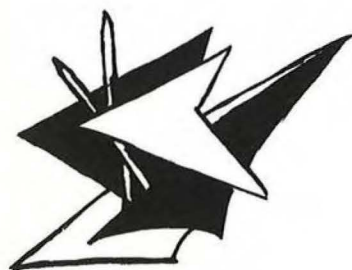

At the outset our plan was simple. Through the use of pictures we would attempt to capture that singular experience entitled: a year at Perth Central School. The year naturally would be the school year 1965-1966, but it would be more than that. To the graduating seniors we would record the key events of this particular year; but we would also structure the book so that the same seniors would be nostalgically carried through his whole high school experience. We soon found, however, that we planned to photograph intangible emotional events that defy any photographer. It was impossible.

How would you photograph the subtle surging electricity that rises slowly but emphatically when after a long bus ride that has worn out larynxes of the early enthusiasts, the bus crosses the Mohawk and drives slowly to the deserted town and a few in the back begin surely but quietly to chant "we are the raiders" and everyone on the bus joins in until the deafening roar rocks the bus "MIGHTY MIGHTY RAIDERS" and all the pent up anticipation and pride of being a Raider erupts and continues and continues until on some back road on a cold brittle night with the full moon reflecting brightly off the crusted snow the bus driver wearily deposits his last hoarse rooster in front of a welcoming lighted driveway.

Forget about photographing - who would want to look at a picture himself if it captured the emotional chaos the first time as a 7th or 8th grader you took the long walk across the huge darkened gym floor to ask for your first dance or if you were the girl hoping that he wouldn't suddenly lose his nerve or losing yours looking frantically for a place to hide.

We have seen pictures of the crowded halls but none show the jostling and bumping that one faces in transit to class or locker. Who's around with a camera for the 1,142,643 laughs one has from September to June. We would like a memento of the exams we creamed but would discard the dismayed one of a blank mind confronting a loaded regents. Agony is first period Gym class outside the first cold, damp November morning; Ecstasy is cold water in the drinking fountains. This also was the year of the hair. And finally there was love, friendships, games, parties, dances, chats and a million other distinctive pieces - a memorabilia that will make this year different from the last or the next.

These and thousands of other experiences will never be photographed. But in the course of putting this book together we realize that we will never forget any of these things. What we really need is simply a memory jogger. An instrument that will identify for our brain releasing a flood of memories: painful, happy, embarrassing, but mostly happy. So although we did not fulfill our original plan, we humbly submit a one-hundred and twelve page memory jogger.
