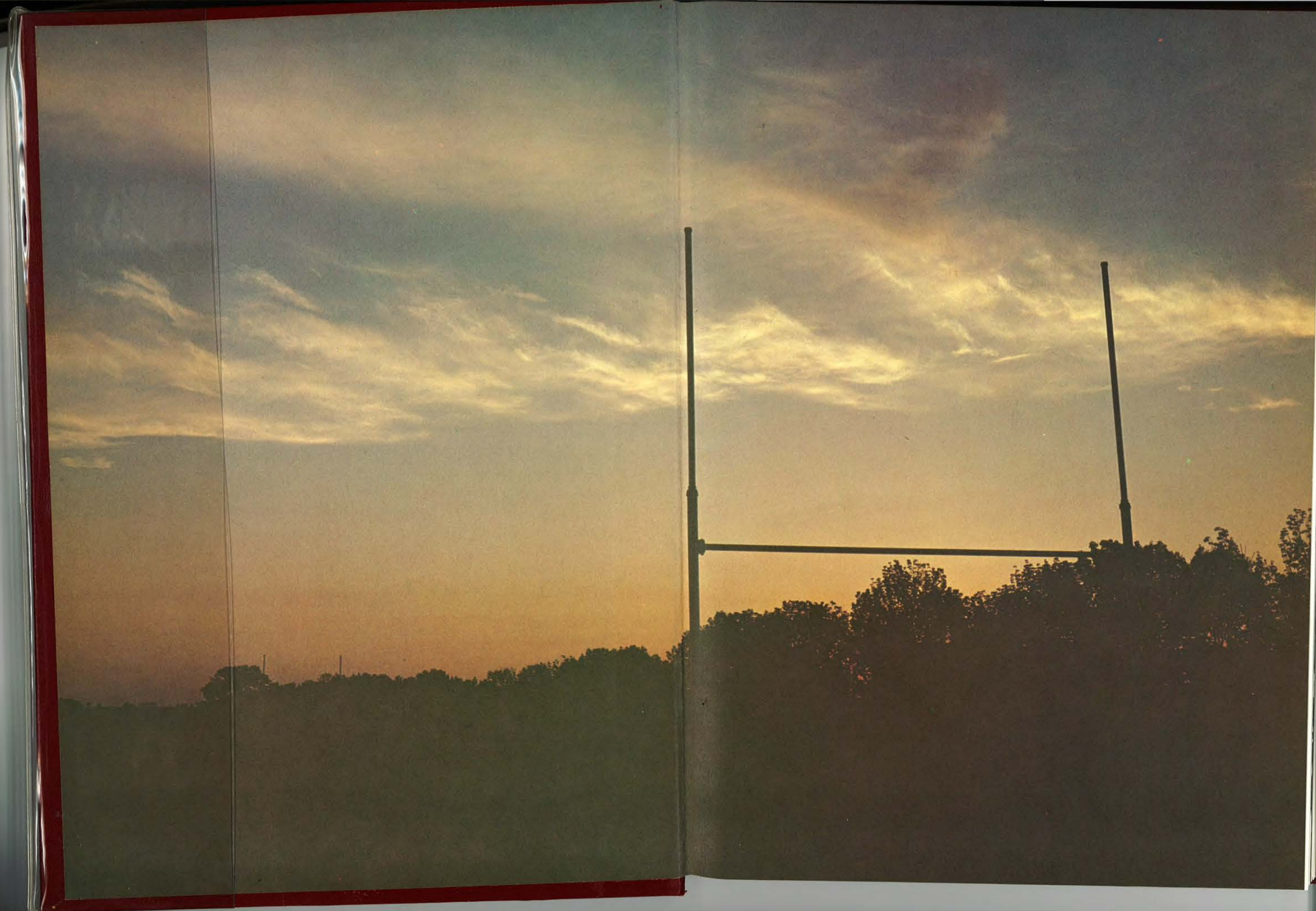

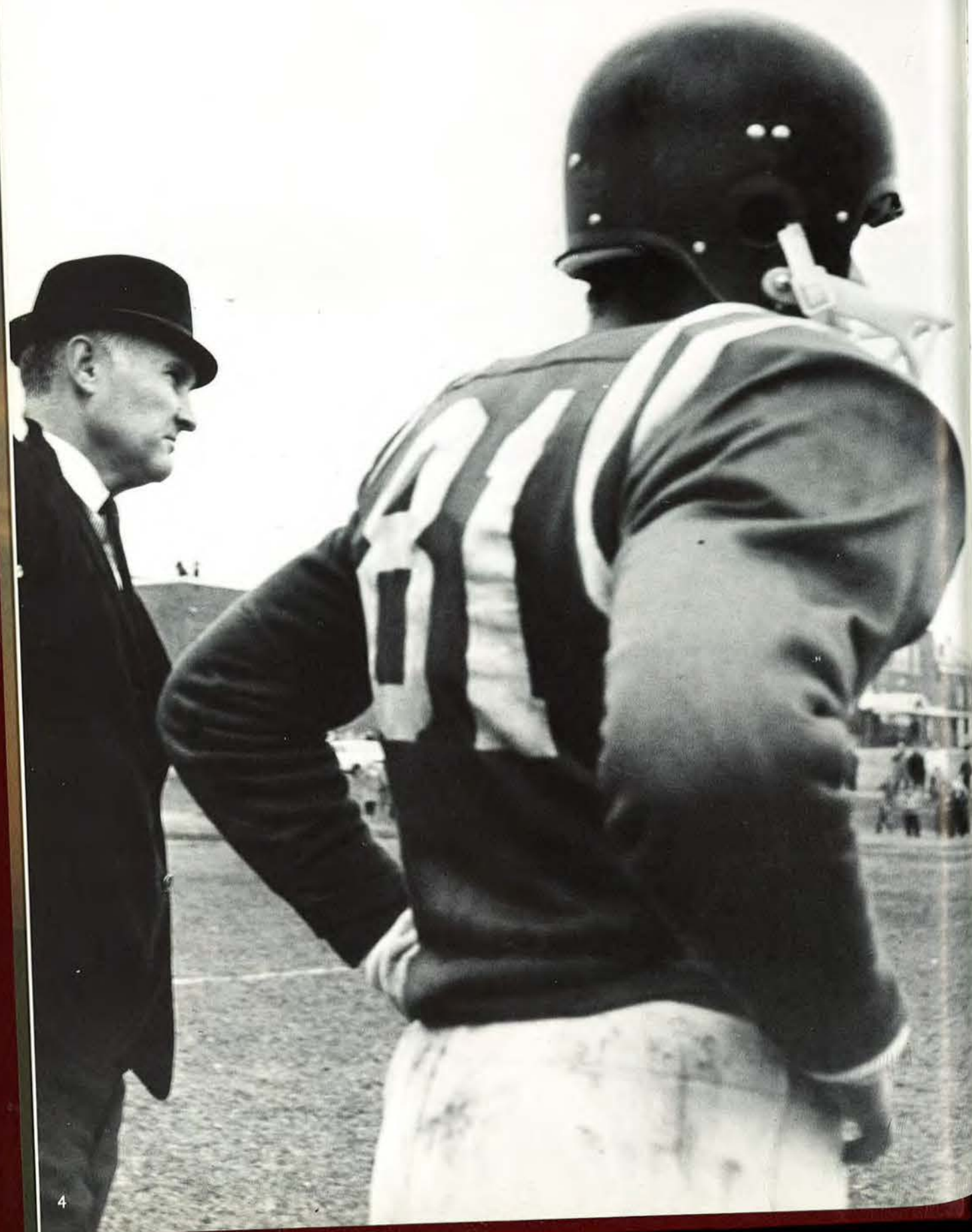

Shining brass cups, commemorative plaques, encased in the southern wall of our lobby, tell the successful story of sport at Perth for the last thirteen years. It is a narrative that began in 1954, when a young graduate of Springfield college became a coach at Perth.

The major leagues lost a potential second baseman, but Perth gained a dedicated coach. In thirteen years of basketball competition there have been only three losing seasons at Perth. A new gym, bowling, and now, football are in part, the result of his efforts. Always he has cared, and sacrificed....

"Victory at any cost" he combines with an athletic requisite--a sportsman's code of conduct. "Remember, boys, we are gentlemen," is a phrase familiar to any boy who has played under him.

Raider Gridmen Post Impressive 4-2-1 Record

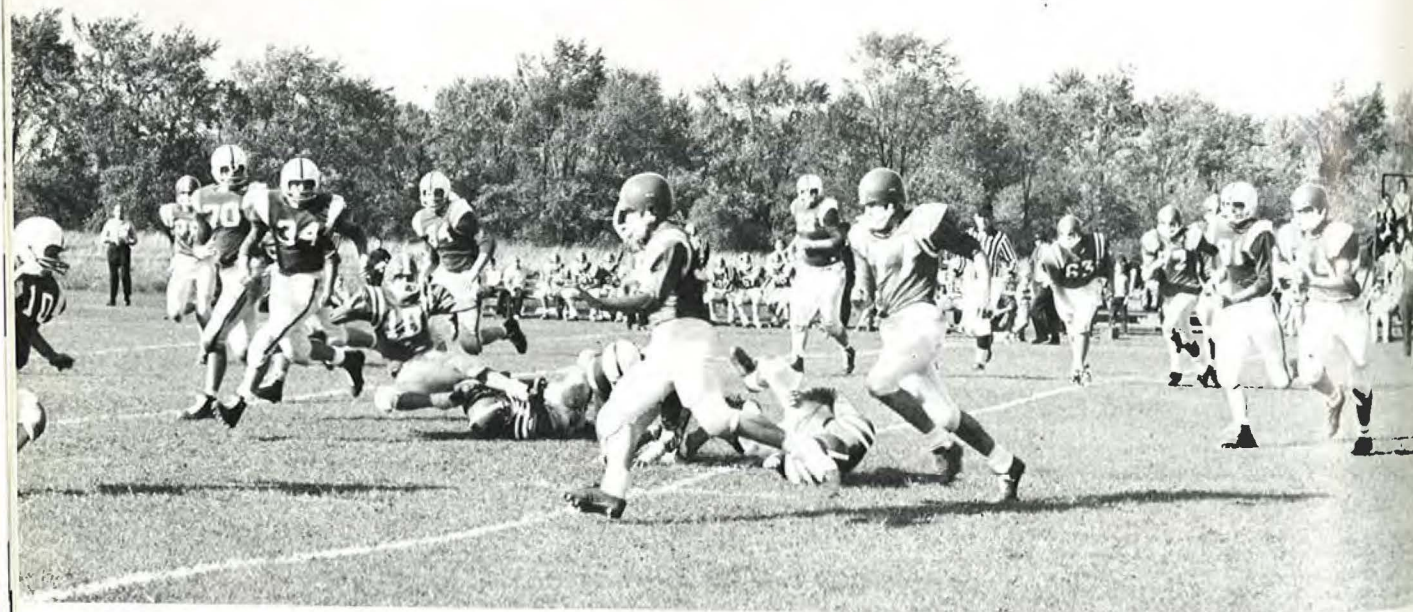

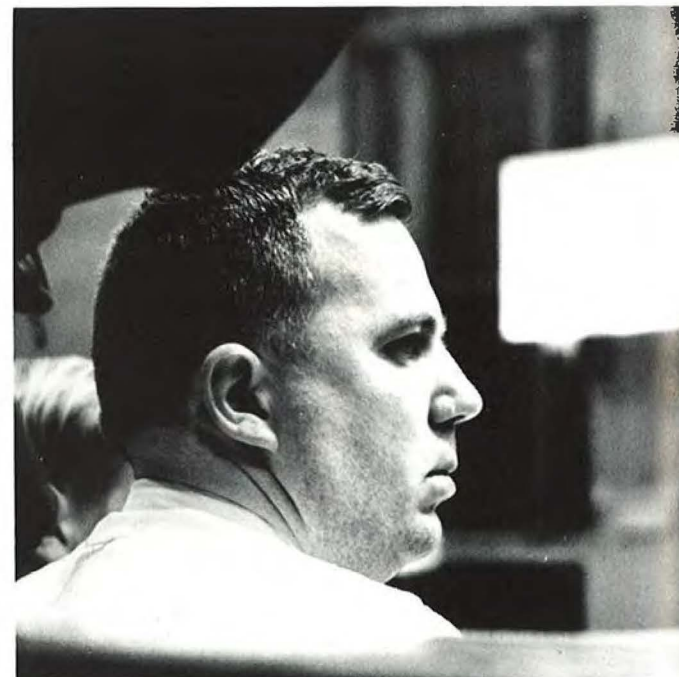
