Participants will also deepen their understanding of how to prioritize culturally and linguistically responsive and sustaining instructional practices and be expected to demonstrate understanding of the key theories and research, evidence-based practices, and identify/enhance ELD practices that are aligned with the Nevada Educator Performance Framework (NEPF).
