

Catholic Communications Campaign

Por over a century, Apostleship of the Sea (AOS) has served merchant sailors around the world by providing sacraments and spiritual renewal through port chaplaincies, as well as hospitality, recreational opportunities, and communication with loved ones at home. In 2013, Apostleship of the Sea of the United States of America developed Stella Maris, the only smartphone app for Catholic merchant sailors. As technology and code systems advanced, the original app became obsolete. In 2022, AOS-USA, using a grant from the Catholic Communication Campaign, rebuilt the app to work on iOS and Android phones. The



updated app keeps Catholic seafarers close to their faith by including a directory of AOS chaplains across the United States and around the world, daily prayers and reflections, a feature that allows sailors to submit their own prayer requests, and a feature that lets cruise passengers know which ships have Catholic priests on board.

Your support of the Catholic Communication Campaign helps AOS-USA engage and build community among Catholic seafarers and their families.

Through websites, social networks, television, radio, and print, the Catholic Communication Campaign (CCC) helps the Church spread the Gospel message through the media locally and nationally.

CCC funds also support communications projects in developing areas of the world where the Church is growing but lacking in resources. The CCC supports the Cardinal Foley Scholarship program which provides funds for training Catholic Communicators from those areas of the world so that they have the tools necessary to spread the Gospel message in the 21st century.

Half of all donations to the CCC collected in your diocese *stay* in your diocese to support your local communications needs,



such as radio and television programming and diocesan publications. The other half supports the collective communication work of the bishops of the United States as well as other national projects in the United States and around the world.




Welcome John League

SOME WORDS OF APPRECIATION

The last of this season's Seasoned Citizens' luncheons took place last week, and it's time to say a few words of appreciation for the amazing leadership and hard work of Heidi Snyder and her team of helpers. So much goes into these luncheons, behind the scenes, that you may not be aware of. Here's a peek at what that looks like.

Early on, she reserves DeSales Hall for six or seven luncheons that take place between September and May. At that time, she plans a theme for each. Shortly before the event, she creates a menu in keeping with the theme and makes her shopping list. Meanwhile, Dagny Shiells creates a unique sign-up page for online registration, and also accepts them via e-mail and phone. She's a working mom who's unable to attend the luncheons, but is a very important part of the planning which has lots of moving parts.

After the food and supplies for each luncheon have been purchased, a staff of volunteers works diligently to prepare the various menu items, sometimes coming in the day before to prep for a large meal such as Thanksgiving and St. Patrick's Day. Other volunteers work at decorating DeSales Hall, dressing the tables, stocking the beverage table, setting up the large buffet table as well as the one for desserts. Coffee is made, sugar and cream are set out, iced tea or lemonade prepared, and whatever else is needed. Volunteers also serve the buffet, and pack up individual meals to-go for those of you who have asked to take one to a shut-in. Occasionally there's

entertainment by our school children or other groups that must be arranged. Announcements of upcoming parish events are made each month, and birthdays are recognized with specially-decorated cupcakes for the celebrants.

As the luncheon ends, volunteers sweep through to clean the tables, while others are in the kitchen washing pots and pans and whatever else needs cleaning. The men and women who volunteer are loyal, dependable, and hardworking, forming a core of workers who, together with Heidi, make everything possible. Under her leadership, our attendance has grown, and this season it's remained steady at about 100 guests each time.

Thanks also to Father Matt, our Pastor, who supports this program which has been ongoing for many years. It's a beautiful way to honor the seniors of our parish! Hospitality is something OLGC is known for, and I invite all those who have attended this year to join me in expressing gratitude to the extraordinary group of men and women who make these luncheons possible. Thank you, everyone!

NEW TRIP

Vienna Parks & Recreation invites those 55 and over to join other area seniors on this trip to visit the Freedom House Museum and the Lee-Fendall House Museum on Thursday, July 13 from 9:30 am-3:30 pm. The Freedom House Museum honors the lives and experiences of the enslaved and free Black people who lived in and were trafficked through Alexandria. You'll explore three floors of exhibitions to learn and reflect on Alexandria's complex history. The Lee-Fendall House Museum and Garden interprets American history through the experiences of the people who lived and worked on the property from 1785 to 1969. You'll

have a docent-led tour which will explore the Lee-Fendall House through the stories of the African Americans who labored in the house as domestic workers, both before and after the Civil War. Lunch will be at the Hard Times Café, and is on your own. The trip fee is \$65 for Vienna town residents, \$81.25 for everyone else. 
