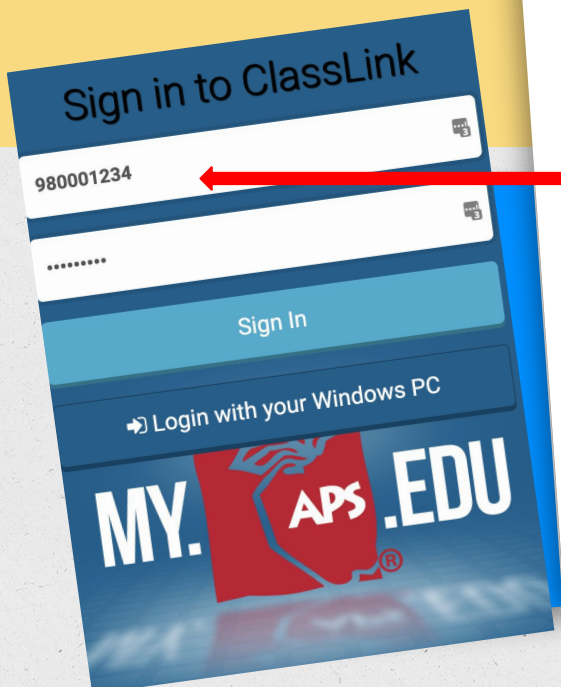




## Tomasita Elementary Guide


How to use

In APS, all students are assigned a student ID number. This same number will be used from kindergarten to 12th grade at all APS schools.


Students can use their APS numbers to sign into many things.

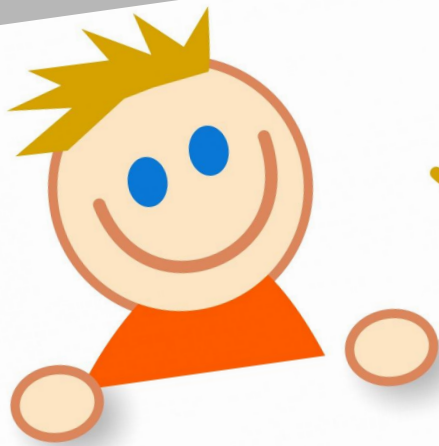

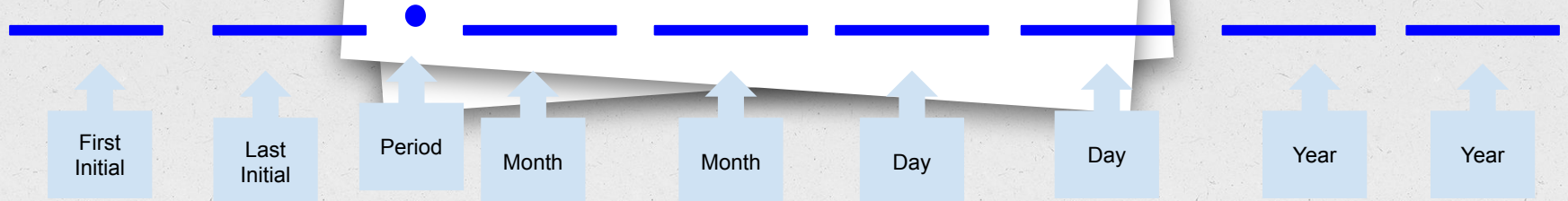
Student **PASSWORDS** are created from the student's personal data.

BIRTHDAYS.

It is important to add  
a zero if needed to  
make it two digits.

The first two items are their first and last  
initials followed by a period. Then the last  
6 are the digits created from their birthday.  
Two digits for month, day, then year.

Only two digits  
for the year.


AARON DONALD
