The question always comes up from students and parents alike, "What do I wear?" Here are some recommendations to help guide you and your child. First, please keep in mind that Eighth Grade Promotion is a liturgy. Boys typically will wear suits or dress pants with a shirt and tie. Girls generally wear dresses, skirts or dressy pant suits. Since promotion is in a liturgical environment, some styles of dress are not appropriate. Examples of styles that are NOT appropriate are; prom style dresses, overly short dresses, low cut, strapless, or very narrow and spaghetti strapped styles. These styles look out of place considering the occasion, liturgy, and the age of the student. Considering the current fashions for young ladies, sleeveless dresses are very popular, and many of these are probably perfect for promotion. However, girls must wear a sweater or jacket over a dress that has a very narrow or spaghetti style strap. As with regular school dress, parents and students are encouraged to use good judgment.
