Thank you for your continued commitment to your student's learning in the remote learning model. As the second semester approaches, we hope to bring students back to school using a phased approach. This approach will begin once Bernalillo County has achieved "green" status based on the state's criteria and maintained that green status for two full weeks.

Although we know that it is not possible to keep COVID-19 out of our schools, we are confident that our safety measures will allow students to come back to school for some in-person opportunities. APS will be following all New Mexico Department of Health Guidelines for the safe return to in-person learning. In addition, we will monitor the public health status regularly and make necessary changes to our in-person and remote learning models when appropriate.
