**Call to Order & Flag Salute**

Ryan Scholl called the meeting to order at 5:02 PM and led the flag salute.

**Approval of Meeting Minutes**

Ryan Scholl called for the review and approval of the minutes from the June 3, 2020 budget committee meeting.

Kellie Smith motioned to approve the minutes.

Melody Killens seconded the motion.

The committee voted unanimously to approve the minutes.

**Budget Committee 2020-2021 Budget Review Questions**

Ryan Scholl opened the floor for budget review questions. There were no questions submitted to Ryan Scholl or Jessica Seay by the June 8, 2020 deadline.

Scot Stockwell offered an opportunity for any new questions or concerns to be addressed.

Jessica Seay provided a response to a question that was asked during the June 3, 2020 meeting regarding the potential reductions that would be made if the legislature did not ensure

the \$9.0 billion State School Fund. She shared the 20-21 General Fund Budget Reduction Bands. Scot Stockwell reviewed the information with the committee.

Kellie Smith asked a clarifying question about the reduction bands.

Trinity Monahan asked a clarifying question about the hiring freeze.

#### **Public Comment on 2020-2021 Proposed Budget**

Ryan Scholl opened the floor for public comment.

No public comments were submitted.

#### **Budget Committee Discussion on Proposed Budget**

Ryan Scholl opened the floor for discussion on the proposed budget.

There were no additional questions or comments.

#### **Approval of Proposed 2020-2021 Budget**

Trinity Monahan moved that the Budget Committee of the St. Helens School District approve the budget for the 2020-2021 fiscal year in the amount of \$53,374,695.

Kellie Smith seconded the motion.

The Budget Committee voted unanimously in favor of the approval of the budget for the 2020-2021 fiscal year.

Trinity Monahan moved that the Budget Committee of the St. Helens School District approve property taxes for the 2020-2021 fiscal year at the rate of \$5.0297 per \$1,000 of assessed value for the permanent rate tax levy, and in the amount of \$2,490,825 for the general obligation bond levy.

Kellie Smith seconded the motion.

The Budget Committee voted unanimously in favor of approving the permanent rate tax levy and the general obligation bond levy for the 2020-2021 fiscal year.
