CALL TO ORDER

Chair Scholl called the School Board Work Session to order at 6:30 p.m. followed by the flag salute.

AGENDA APPROVAL

Bill Amos entered a motion to approve the agenda as presented. Trinity Monahan seconded; the motion to approve the agenda carried unanimously.

CONSENT AGENDA

Melody Killens entered a motion to approve the consent agenda as presented. Trinity Monahan noted a date correction was needed (from 2022 to 2021) on the second page of each Revitalization Safety Videos IGA. He seconded the motion with that correction in place; the motion to approve the consent agenda carried unanimously.

NEW BUSINESS

- Superintendent Stockwell noted that he would like to change the schedule of June Board meetings in years when one of them falls during the same week as graduation, so members can attend graduation events without conflict.
- Superintendent Stockwell reported that he met with Dr. Wagner and the SHHS registrar to discuss the matter of temporarily suspending the World Languages requirement, due to the pandemic, for 2023 and 2024 graduates. The standard will still be in place going forward. Members reiterated their wish to have World Languages available at the middle school level, and to add additional language options for students.
- Kellie Smith requested that building-level activities be added to the Major Events calendar, for easier access.
- Trinity Monahan requested entrance and exit be arranged with students so that the Board is able to get some direct feedback about their experience in the District. Melody Killens suggested also obtaining feedback from students one year after graduation.
