**CALL TO ORDER BUDGET HEARING**

Chair Scholl called the Budget Meeting to order at 6:30 p.m. followed by the Pledge of Allegiance. Trinity Monahan entered a motion to approve the agenda as presented. Melody Killens seconded; the motion to approve the agenda carried unanimously.

**BUDGET HEARING**

There were no questions or comments presented prior to the hearing or by members regarding the proposed 2022-23 Budget. Resolution 2021-22 #12 – Adopting the Budget, Making Appropriations and Imposing and Categorizing the Tax was provided to members in advance of the meeting for review.

**CALL TO ORDER**

Chair Scholl called the Regular Board Meeting to order at 6:37. Melody Killens entered a motion to approve the agenda as presented. Trinity Monahan seconded; the motion to approve the agenda carried unanimously.

### VISITORS TO ADDRESS THE BOARD

- Paul Hayduk, parent and community member sent two questions to the Board via email prior to the meeting. Chair Scholl read the questions aloud:
  - Will SHHS have open lunch during the 2022-23 school year? If not, does the school board agree with Mr. Stockwell's assessment and decision?
  - Previously Mr. Stockwell stated that a "running start" program would be available to all students in the 2022-23 school year at SHHS. Communications sent out about 2 months ago stated that the counselors were looking for 15 sophomores who might be interested. Can you please clarify if all students have the opportunity to participate or is it limited?

Superintendent Stockwell reported that campus will be closed for lunch next year, to align with security plans in place for students.

Superintendent Stockwell reported that the District will start the Early College High School (ECHS) in the fall, as planned. The program is a two-year program, so 15 Sophomores will be chosen so they can complete the program during their junior and senior years of high school. There will be 15 additional spots open during the 2023-24 school year. Juniors and seniors can gain dual credits outside of the ECHS program at SHHS.

### CONSENT AGENDA

Melody Killens entered a motion to approve the consent agenda as presented. Trinity Monahan seconded; the motion to approve the agenda carried unanimously.

### NEW BUSINESS

- Superintendent Stockwell reported that the Board Planning Meeting will take place on Wednesday, July 13 at 6:30. He will schedule a Board retreat in August, the date for which will be announced soon.
- Jessica Seay referred to Resolution 2021-22 #13 – Surplus Property, which was provided to members prior to the meeting. The resolution will provide approval for the house completed by the Renovation & Remodeling Program this year (374 South 15<sup>th</sup>) to be sold. Trinity Monahan expressed his appreciation for the excellent work Joe Mauk continues to do with the program, and for all of the many volunteer hours Bill Amos invests in it. Bill noted that some of the seniors in the program asked to come back to help finish the project, even after they had graduated.


