

What is Title I?

The **Ferndale Area School District's** Title I program is a federally funded supplemental educational program that provides financial assistance to improve educational opportunities for students needing assistance in Reading and Mathematics. Title I programs are designed to help children meet the state content in performance standards in Reading, Language Arts, and Mathematics.

Currently, the Ferndale Area School District's Title I program is a School Wide program that benefits all students and teachers in the Elementary building. Two Reading Specialists, a Title I Aide and part of the Federal/State Programs Coordinator are funded through the Title I program. Title I funds are also used for math and reading instructional supplies, to support an after school tutoring program, teacher professional development, pupil personnel services, staff and community support services and mandated nonpublic instructional services.
