This camp runs Tuesday through Friday from 8:30 am until 12:00 pm.** Our Summer Camp team has spent the last several months preparing for an awesome summer for your camper. What to bring to camp each day:

- Playground safe shoes that are easy to independently put on for the playground.
- Campers may wear dance attire (leotard and dance shoes) while in the theatre but will need a t-shirt and shorts to enter camp, walk around campus, and to exit camp.
- One bag to keep all your belongings together.
- Water bottle
- A snack

Daily activity:

Welcome to the first week of Theater Dance Camp! Our theme is Neverland which will take us into the unknown and on all kinds of magical adventures! We will begin each day with stretching, move into leaning choreography, create props and costumes, enjoy a nice recess on our playground, and then rehearse various parts of our show!

Arrival procedures for campers:

- Enter from Maclay Road and veer to your left. The Cartee Gym is located adjacent to the Dining Hall & Performance Center. Please drop off between 8:20 and 8:30am. Do not get out of the car. Someone will be there to greet your camper and get them checked in. If you arrive late, call Mrs. Nettles at (850)381-0278 and someone will come out front to get your child.
- **There is not any early drop off this week as our staff is still in post planning.**

Pick up procedures for campers:

Please pull up to the Cartee Gym west doors (adjacent to the playground) between 11:50 am and 12:00 pm. Do not get out of the car. Someone will be there to radio for your child to be escorted out to your vehicle. If you need to pick up prior to 12:00pm please call Mrs. Nettles at (850) 381-0278 and someone will walk your child out to you. **Make sure you know your family's PIN (4 digit number) to pick up the camper.**

There are not any other options available for extended care this week. All campers need to be picked up by 12:00.

Camp safety:

Maclay has a registered nurse on campus to help support the safety and wellness of our campers. All campers must sign a waiver, produce immunization records, and follow our safety protocols. Before arrival to camp each morning, please screen your child for presence of acute illness symptoms. Any camper with symptoms present will be asked to stay home until symptoms have resolved (without the use of medication) for at least 24 hours. As always, seek medical attention and testing when appropriate.

The following is a list of symptoms:

- Fever ≥ 100.0 or chills
- Nausea or vomiting
- Diarrhea
- Cough
- Congestion or runny nose*
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing*
- Fatigue
- Muscle or body aches
- Headache*
- New loss of taste or smell

** We understand some of these symptoms are present with chronic medical conditions (i.e., migraines, allergies, asthma, etc.) Please have medical conditions and diagnoses listed on camper's medical form prior to enrollment.*

Thank you for practicing and modeling good hand hygiene and staying home when sick.

Please communicate with the Health Center if you are keeping your child home for illness and/or injury related reasons so that we may discuss our return to camp guidelines related to specific diagnoses.
