

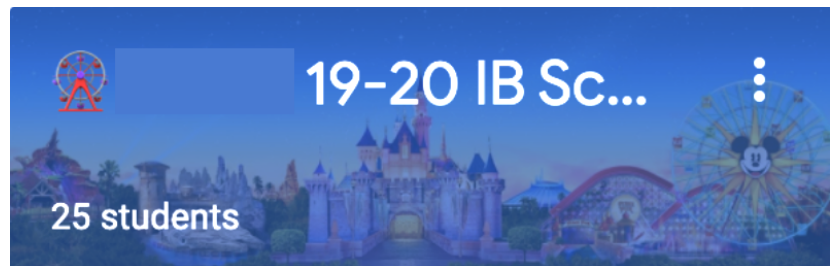
Linking Aeries to Google Classroom (Elementary)

You can create your Google Classrooms by opening <http://classroom.google.com> . Title your classrooms so they are easy to identify. After your classrooms are set up, open and log into Aeries.

Linking Google Classroom to Aeries

- Student rosters will import into your Google Classroom automatically.
- Student rosters in Aeries will be updated (added and dropped) from your Google Classroom nightly.

Create your Google Classroom with a title that easily identifies with the course.

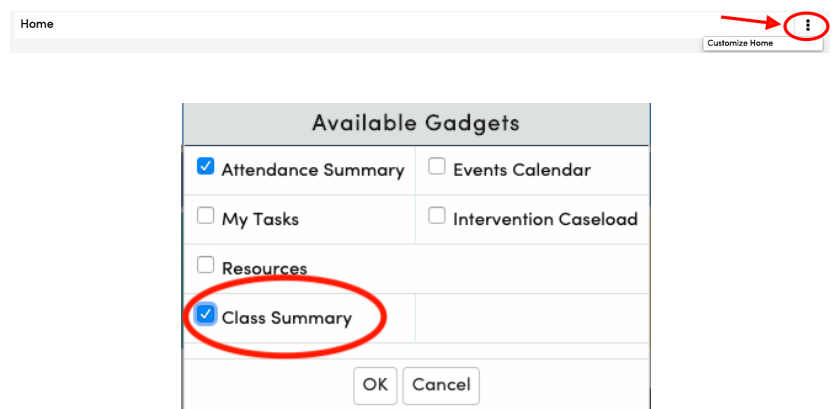

Note: If you do not see the **Class Summary** on the home page: click the three dots in the upper right corner of your Aeries window.

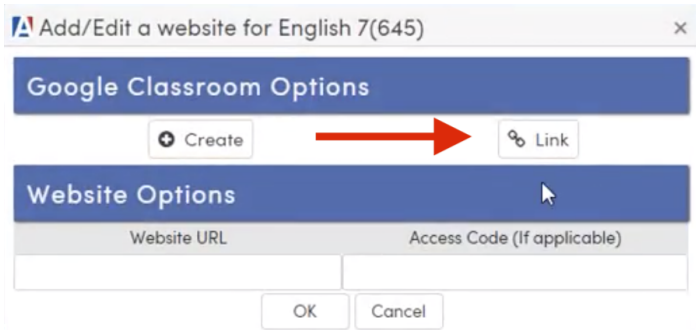
- Select **Customize Home**
- From the **Available Gadgets**, check the **Class Summary** option. Click **OK**.



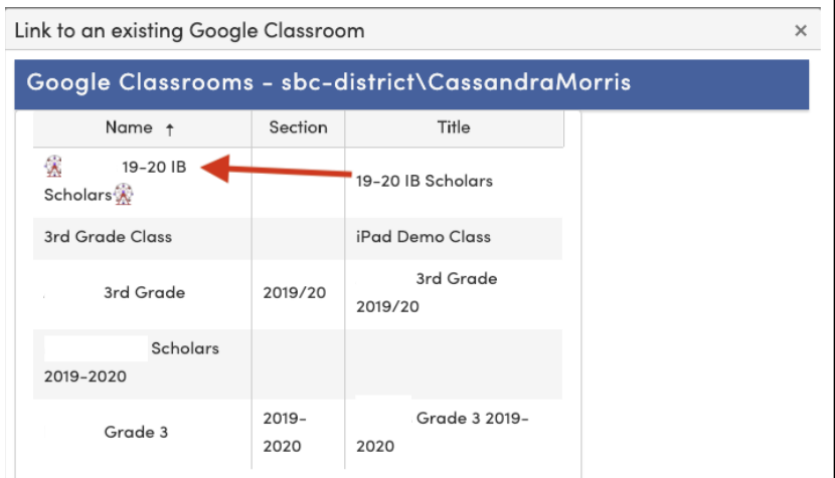
Select the class you would like to import to Google Classroom and click on the **Add Website** button.



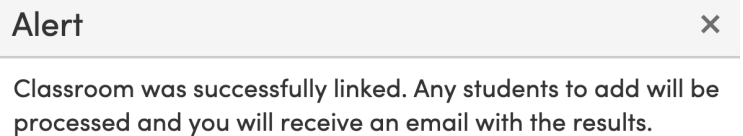
In the popup window, select **Link** to connect your existing Google Classroom to Aeries.
