

## Numbers and Counting Choice Board



The students are currently working on counting numbers and objects for the numbers 1 through 20.

<p>Write the numbers from 1 to 20 in crayon. Say the names of the numbers as you write them.</p>	<p>Choose 5 numbers. Draw a picture to show a model for each number.</p>	<p>Choose a group of objects. Count the number of items. Count at least 3 different groups of objects.</p>
<p>Write the numbers in shaving cream, sand, rice, etc.</p>	<p>Use playdough to make the numbers and put the numbers in order.</p>	<p>Write the numbers on index cards. Put the numbers in order from smallest to biggest.</p>
<p>Get a deck of cards. Say the name of the number. Count objects to match the number.</p>	<p>Get two dice. Roll the dice. Count the number of dots on the dice.</p>	<p>Play a board game in which you have to count to move your piece. (Ex. Chutes and Ladders, Monopoly Jr.)</p>
