Superintendent's Report:

Dr. Aronstein reported:

- The additional Deasy Kindergarten class, which was established to address an
 unanticipated increase in enrollees, has 14 students currently. The teacher has 6
 years of experience as a Kindergarten teacher. The class will be held to 17 students.
 The remaining classes will be held to 19-24 students and each will have a teacher
 and teacher assistant. Additionally a teacher assistant will also be assigned to rotate
 among the 22-24 student classes.
- The Audit Report from the Office of the State Comptroller will be posted on the website tomorrow and a presentation will be made at the Board meeting on October 19.
- The Audit Committee met with the external auditor Nawrocki Smith LLP. The financial statements will be presented later in November.
- The Thayer House boiler is being replaced.
- H1N1 flu update: Subsequent to meeting with the NC Health Commissioner, the following recommendations are being made: 1) Nasal spray vaccination is not recommended for children, pregnant women, or persons with respiratory problems; 2) Regular flu shots are compatible with H1N1 vaccinations; 3) Hospitals and designated centers will provide inoculations, Manhasset being the closest at this time; 4) The School District is discussing with the School Doctor, Dr. Screnci, the possibility of providing H1N1 vaccinations through the school with parental consent.
