- **Mr. Warren Richmond**, attorney, presented a summary of the outcome of recent grievances by the Glen Cove Teachers Association.

- Questions and comments from members of the audience were fielded by the attorneys.

### **Report:**

- **Dr. Aronstein** delivered a summary of the events associated with an alleged attempted abduction incident involving a Middle School student that occurred in the community on Thursday, September 20, 2007. A suspect was charged with "endangering the welfare of a child."

**Presentation:**

- **Dr. Aronstein** presented an overview of the five District Goals, developed between the Board of Education and the Superintendent, for the 2007/2008 school year. He addressed questions from the audience regarding these District Goals.

**Superintendent's Report:**

**Dr. Aronstein** reported that there is a trend that indicates an increasing number of students returning into the District from private and parochial schools since the 2005/2006 academic year.

**Comments from the Public:**
