Dual Monitor Solution

CONTROL OF CHTY SCHOOL OF

- 39 classrooms with dual monitor setup
- Feedback from teachers has all been positive
 - Less dropping of google meets
 - Able to share screen AND see all students
 - Easier teaching overall

Temporary solution - COVID times - once computer labs open, monitors will need to be put back

ZOOM

- District purchased Zoom for Educators
- Teachers have the option to use Zoom or continue with Google meet
- Gustavo professional development for teachers
- Zoom Features:
 - Automatic attendance reports
 - Built in white board
 - Breakout rooms
 - Built in Q&A (multiple choice)
 - Built in polls
- Trial of 25 teachers across the district
 - Great feedback breakout rooms, attendance, waiting room, polls, etc
 - No reports of "dropping" zoom sessions
 - Working with zoom to create SSO so that students DO NOT make their own accounts

STUDENT HOTSPOTS AND WIFI

- 250 hotspots out to students in the district
- Reaching out to families that are showing "zero usage" devices to see if they no longer need the devices and we can repurpose them for other families - has yielded about 20 devices to be returned
- Optimum Wifi through BOCES
 - 20 licenses to start
 - Can add batches of 10
 - Goes on individual MAC address
 - ONLY district provided Chromebook or iPad will connect
 - Currently using 18 of the 20 licenses
