Smart Schools Bond Act



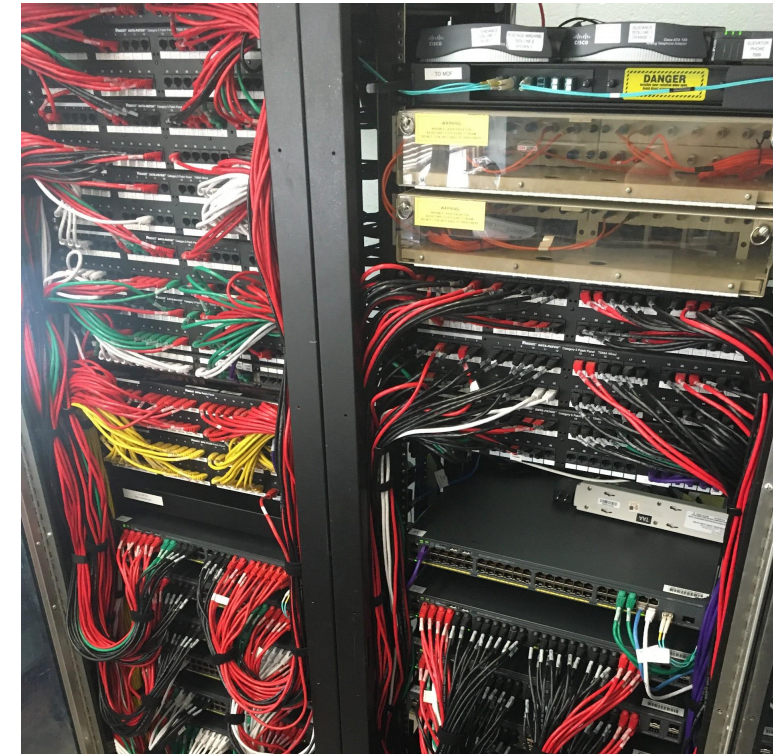
The **New York Bonds for School Technology Act, Proposal 3** was approved by voters in New York State and allows districts to utilize such funds for projects related to these four categories:

School Connectivity	Install high-speed broadband or wireless internet
Classroom Technology	Acquire learning technology equipment or facilities, including but not limited to interactive whiteboards, computer servers, and desktop, laptop, and tablet computers;
Pre-K Classrooms	Construct, enhance, and modernize educational facilities to accommodate pre-kindergarten programs and to provide instructional space to replace classroom trailers; and
High Tech Security Features	Install high-tech security features in school buildings and on school campuses, including but not limited to video surveillance, emergency notification systems, and physical access controls.

Glen Cove and Smart Bond Act



- ❑ GCCSD applied for a Smart Bond project to be approved by New York State Education Department in 2017.
- ❑ While waiting to be approved, for over a year, NYS Education Department policy changed for the Smart Bond which resulted in the application being returned to us to be amended.
- ❑ In the meantime, we have completed the original necessary projects that were proposed using alternative funding available to us; E-rate funding.
- ❑ Funding is now available to us once again and we are proposing a Smart Bond project to utilize the funds.



Glen Cove School District's Allocation of Smart Schools Bond

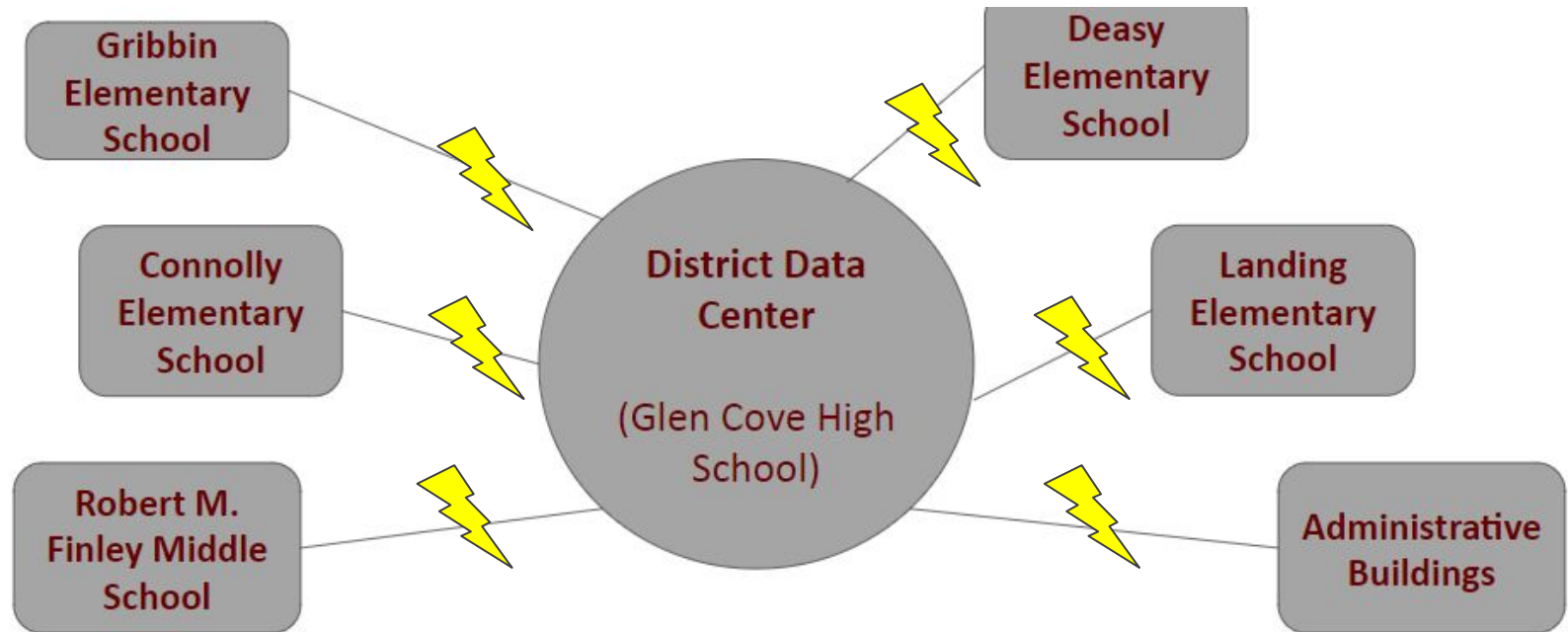
