



4. Enter the Parent details in the YELLOW FIELDS making sure to enter a valid email address and password using the PINK REQUIREMENTS. Then enter the student's name as it is in PowerSchool and the ACCESS ID and PASSWORD in the BLUE FIELDS. The relationship field should be filled with the parent's relationship to the student. Repeat for Additional Students and hit Enter at the bottom right hand corner of the page.



5. Upon completion, you will be sent an email from Blount County Schools <u>powerschool@blountboe.net</u> (this is not a monitored account). To verify your account you will need to click the link or paste it in a new browser window.




6. Once verified you can use the <a href="https://blountco.powerschool.com/">https://blountco.powerschool.com/</a> portal to view your student's grades.

# If you would like to track student grades by the phone application, search for PowerSchool in your app store of choice.

1. Once you have installed the PowerSchool app, you will be presented a request for a district code. Blount County is **J J M T**. It will then ask if we are located in Canada, click no. You should now see a login screen to use your recently created PowerSchool Parent Access Account... students can use their school email and lunch number to access the app.



1. Once logged in you will see a student dashboard. You can swap students by touching the student picture or initials in the top left corner.



2. The Dashboard grades are based on Semester level for High School students and Yearly for Grades 4-6. To see a current grading period, select the subject and then click the grading term you would like to see.
