

Mandarin Chinese 3 Regular and 3 Advanced

Optional Summer Assignment

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This summer assignment is to help you review Mandarin 2 to get ready for Mandarin 3 class over the summer break. This is an INDIVIDUAL, OPTIONAL but highly recommended assignment. This assignments must be completed between 6/1/2023 and 8/14/2023.

Learning Targets:

To be able to use target language in handling simple daily life activities through interpretive and presentational communications.

TEKS:

1B. Interpretive Communication: demonstrate understanding of simple, clearly spoken, and written language such as simple stories, high-frequency commands, and brief instructions when dealing with familiar topics.

5A. Use the language both within and beyond the school setting through activities such as participating in cultural events and using technology to communicate.

Assignment

Do **Duolingo** assignments. If you are new to Duolingo, take the placement test and start at the level most appropriate for you (recommended levels 2-4). This will be a blend of review as well as learning some new materials.

Every 250 XP of Duolingo, is one free quiz grade. This will take you approximately 2 hours. You can earn up to 4 quiz grades, 1 applicable to each grade period in the coming school year.

If you are on a smartphone or tablet:

1. Download the **Duolingo** app and open it up.
2. Press **Get Started**. Then select **Chinese**.
3. Set your Daily Goal and continue (you can change this later).
4. Create a Profile:
 -  On Android, press the menu icon at the top right corner and press **Create a Profile**.
 -  On iOS, press **Profile** in the top left corner and press **Create a Profile**.
5. Type in your **Name**, **Email** and **Password**, then press **Create**.
6. Go to your **Profile** and press **Progress Sharing**.
7. Type in your Classroom Code: **WXJSQP**
8. Press **Join**
