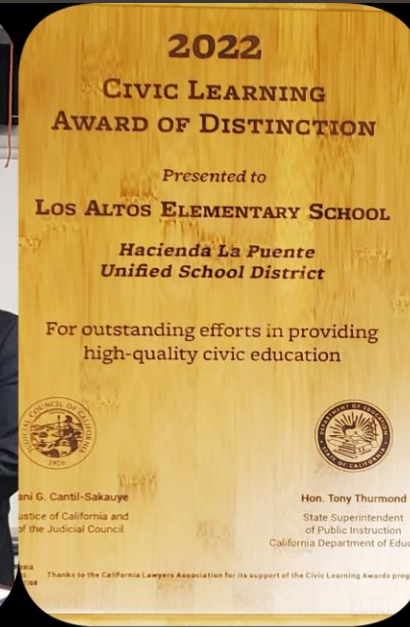

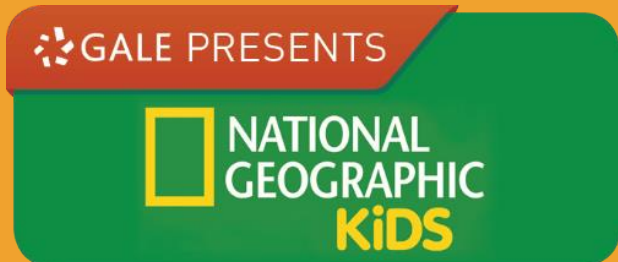


Hacienda La Puente Unified School District Equity And Access Family Engagement

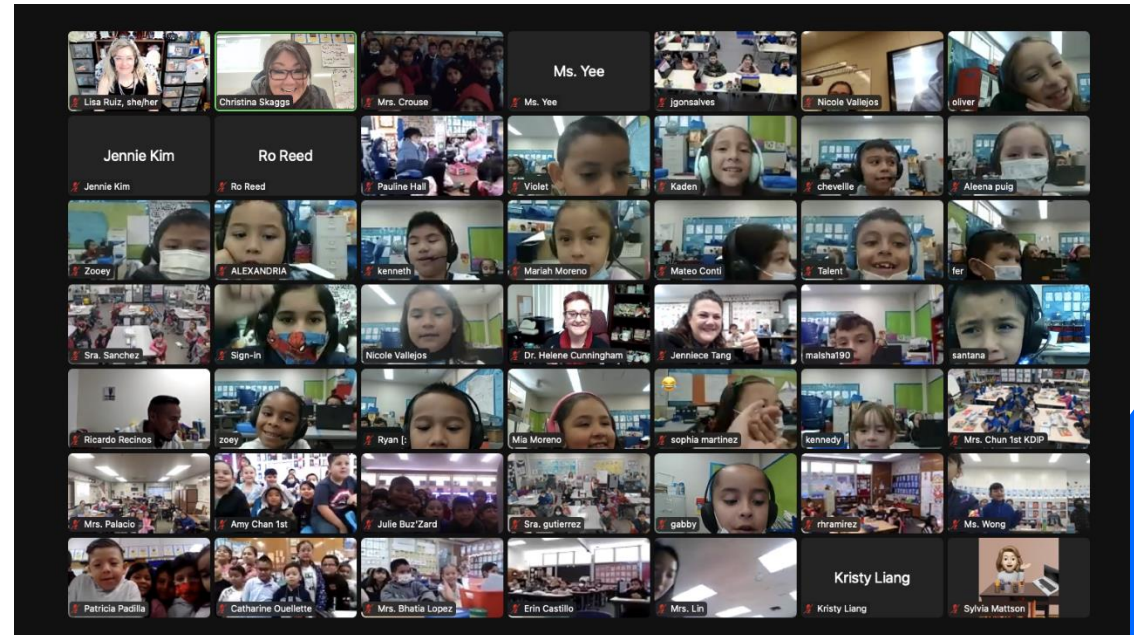
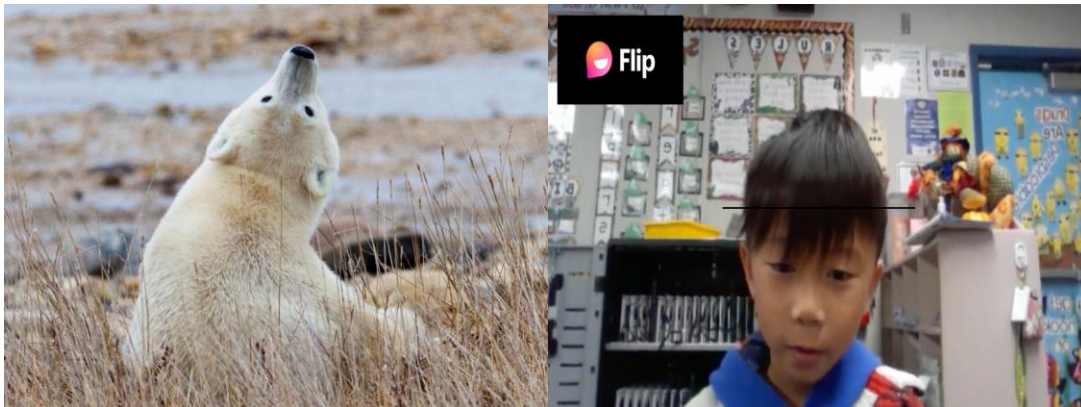
Discovery Science: Polar Bear

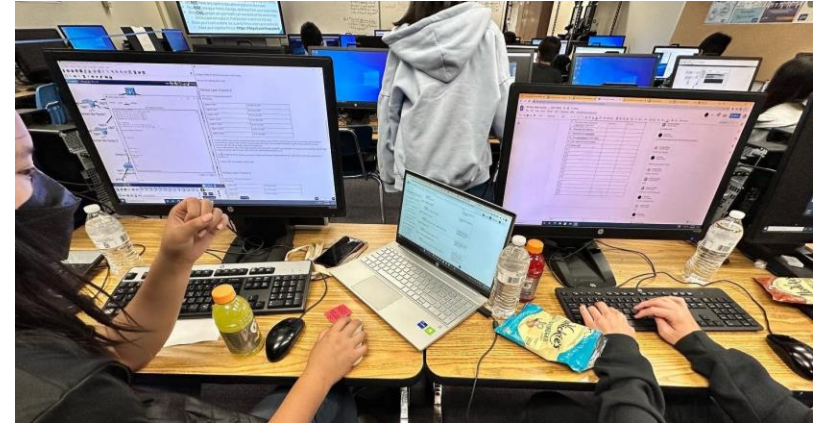
HLPUSD Members were invited to NHC Open House event at their new location in La Puente.

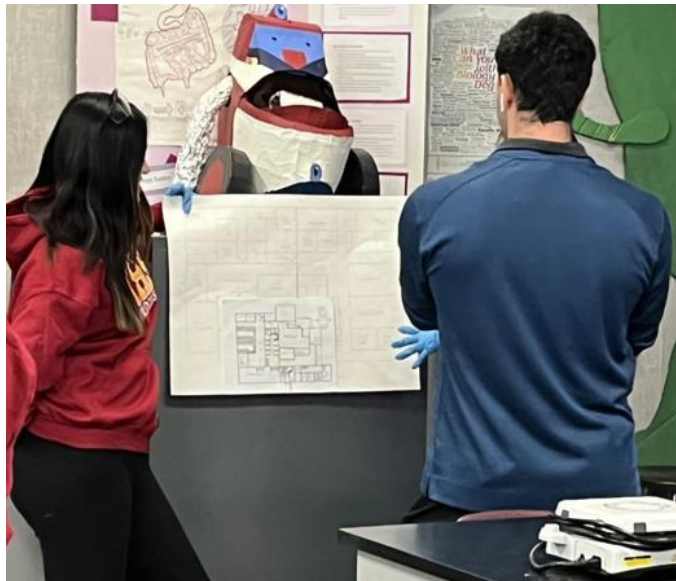

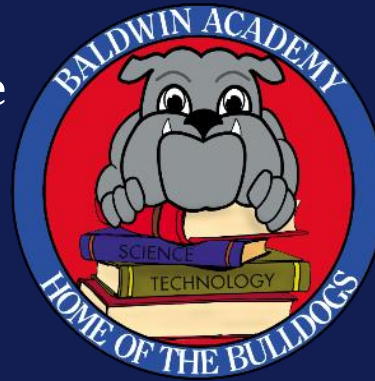
PARENT & FAMILY ENGAGEMENT

BALDWIN ACADEMY ensures our parents are active participants in person and online using Microsoft Translate in their recent ELAC meeting.

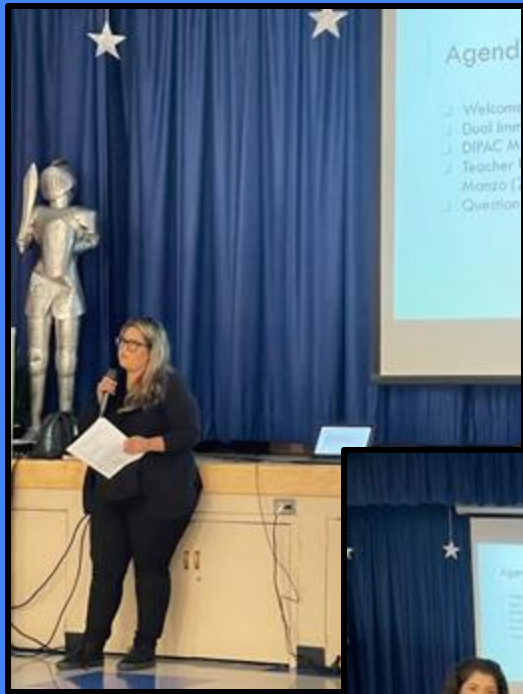

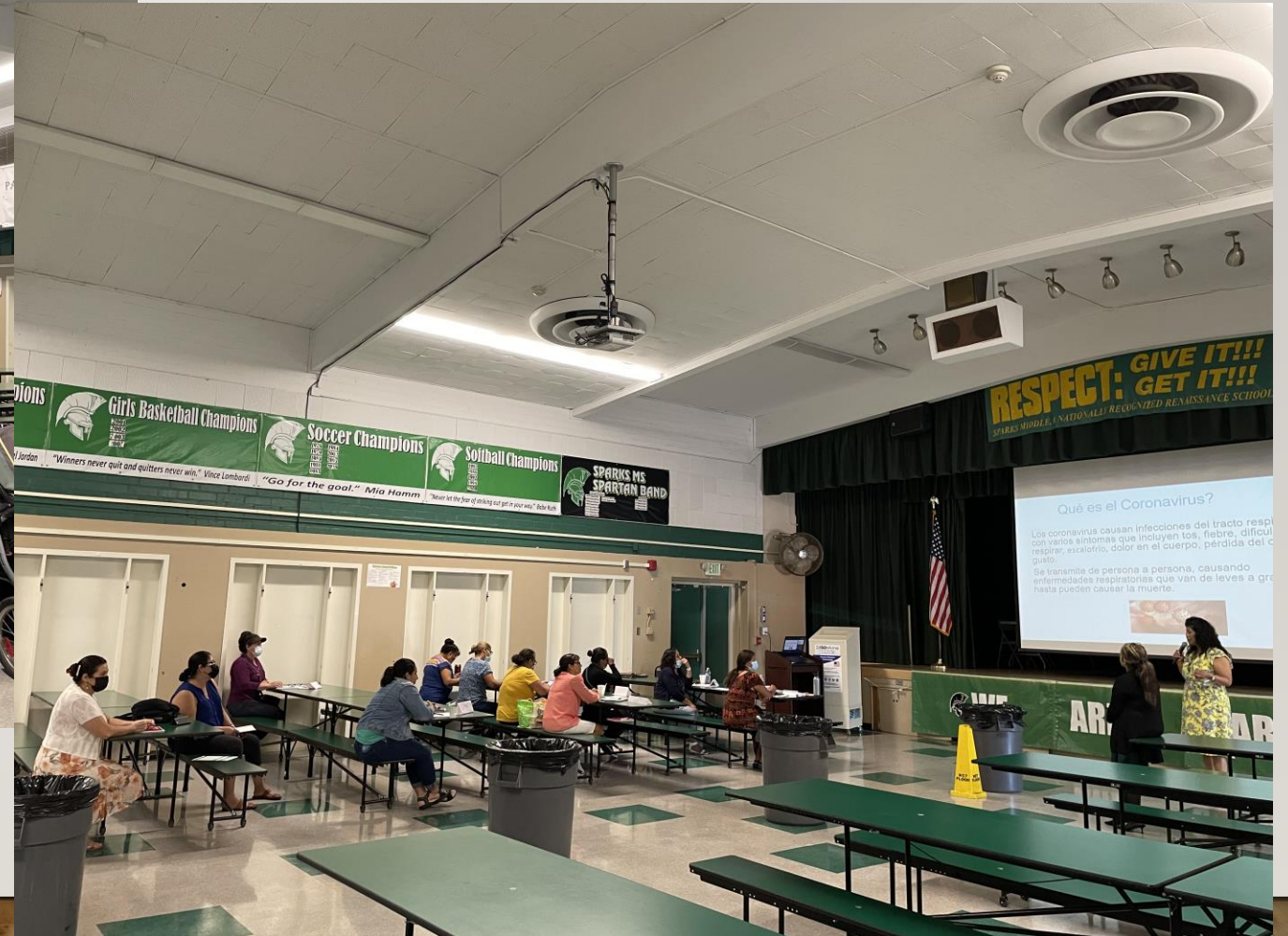
