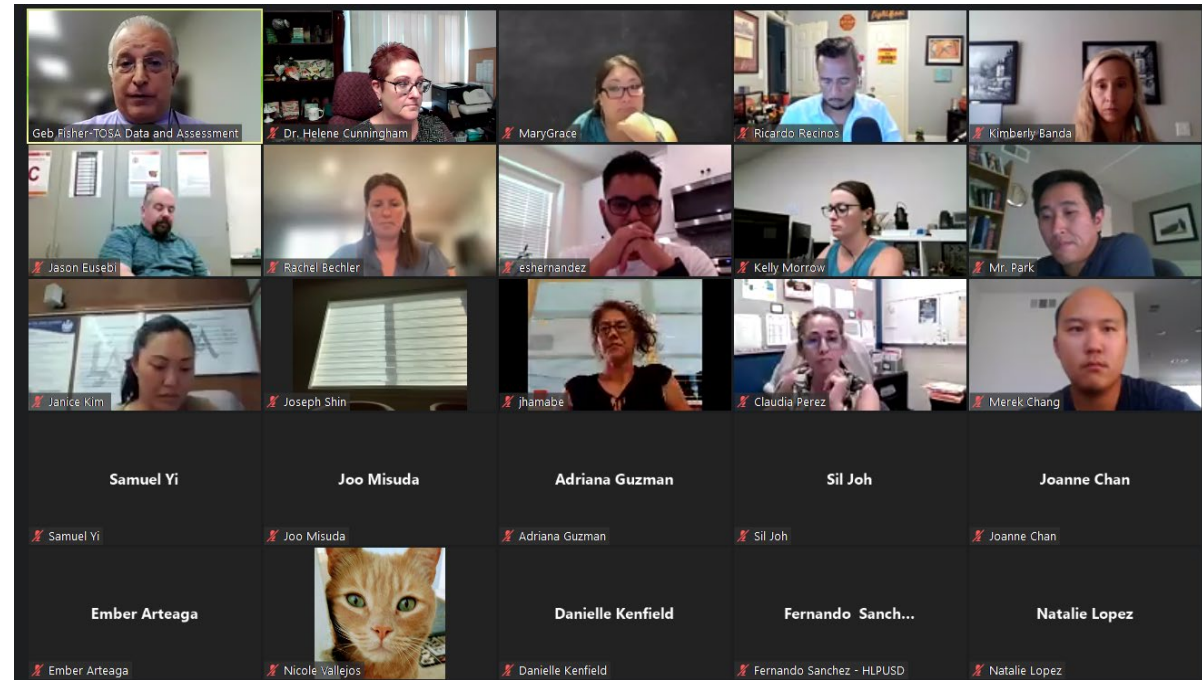

## YCP Mission

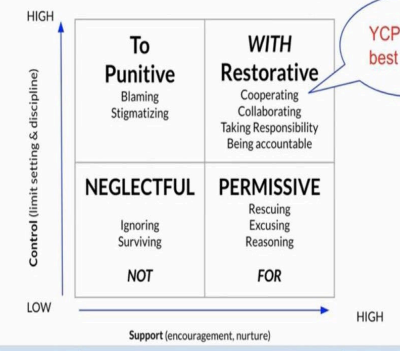
The Youth Cinema Project (YCP) works in the classrooms of public schools, integrating filmmaking with 21st century learning skills. YCP uses a hands-on approach that integrates social emotional learning and English Language Arts to provide an equitable and accessible learning experience for students. 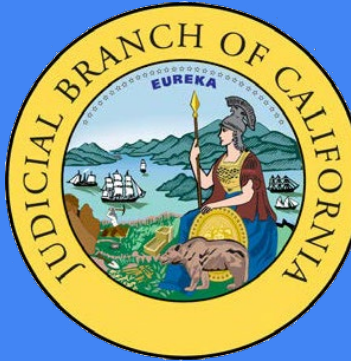
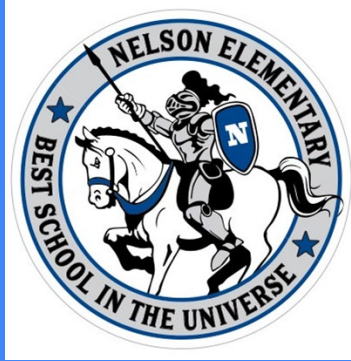
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# Nelson Elementary

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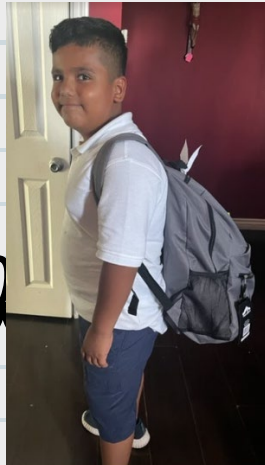
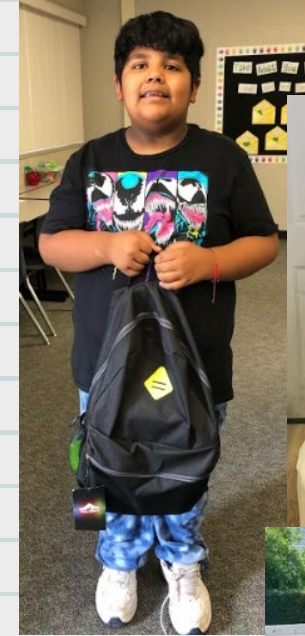


# Hacienda La Puente Unified School District Equity and Access, Family Engagement

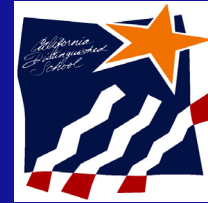

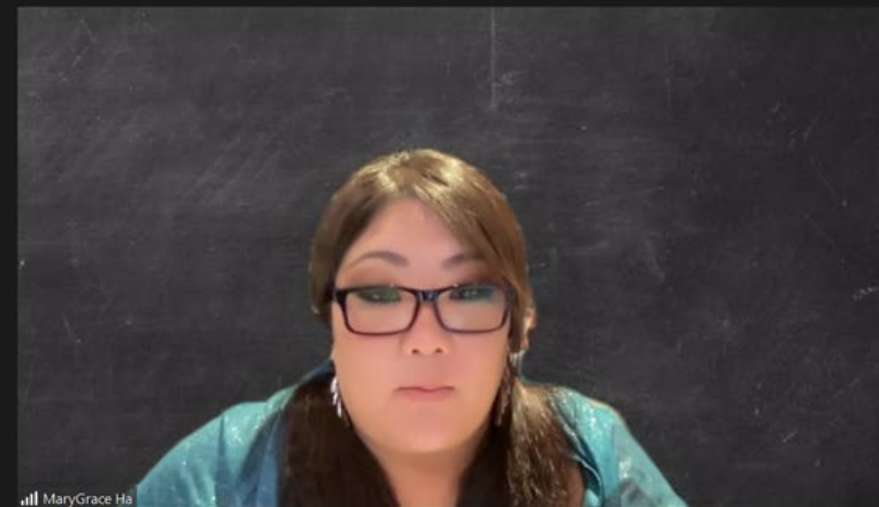
