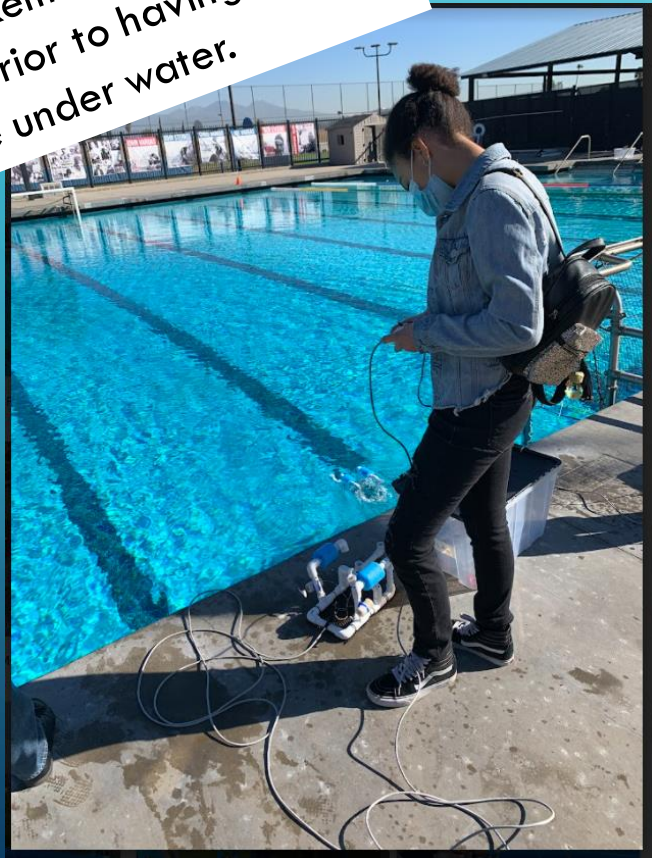

Students are testing their ROV's in the water to make some final adjustments.



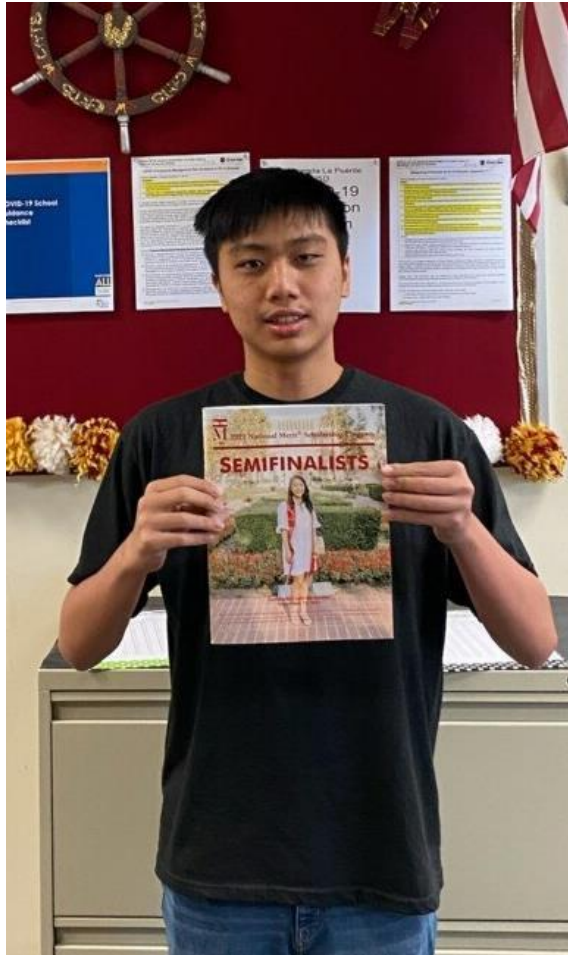

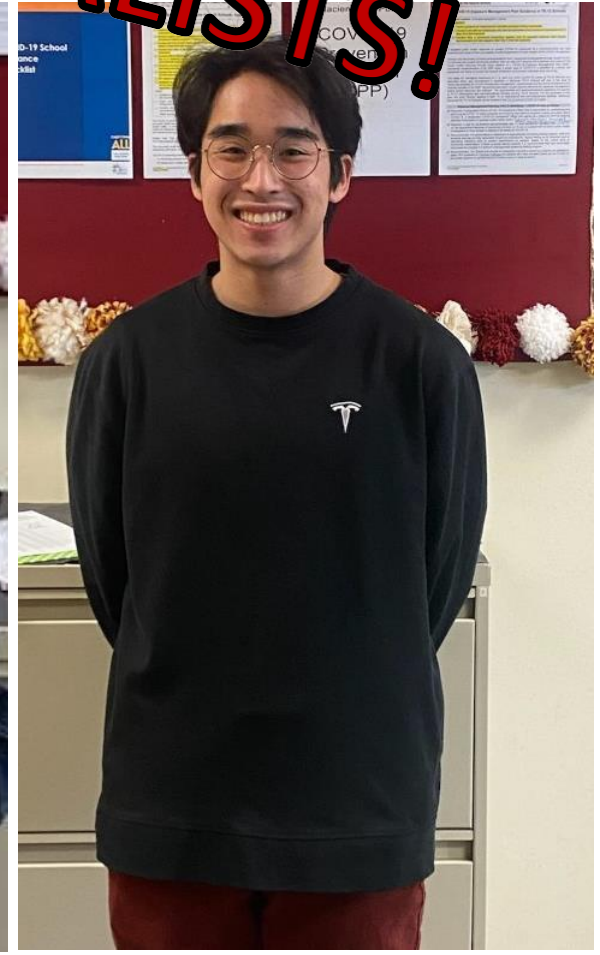

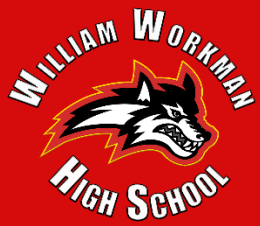
