**Deepens human desire to connect to others to do good**

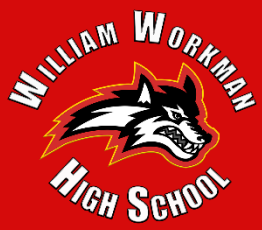
