



Ingredients:

2 Boxes of Vanilla

Wafers -

2 Boxes of Vanilla Instant Pudding (Can

use any instant pudding)

1 Container of Cool

Whip

4 Cups of Milk

3-4 Ripe Bananas



Instructions:

1)Combine 2 boxes of instant pudding and 4 cups of milk in a large bowl. This means you will use two cups of milk per box of pudding.

2)Use a whisk or hand mixer and whisk/mix until all the lumps are gone.

3)Add 1 cup of whipped cream into your pudding mixture.

4)Fold the whipped cream, DO NOT WHIP OR STIR in order to keep the pudding light, fluffy, and airy.

5)Set pudding aside, pull out the bowl to layer the ingredients.

6)Layer vanilla wafers to cover the bottom of the bowl.

7)Peel and slice bananas and layer on top of the wafers.

8)After layering the wafers and bananas, add a generous amount of pudding Continue this process of layering until the ingredients reach the top of the bowl.

9)Once the layering is complete, refrigerate the dessert until chilled.
