Senate Bill (SB) 98

Learning Continuity and Attendance Plan

SB 98, approved by Governor Newsom on June 29, 2020, established that:

- The Local Control and Accountability Plan (LCAP) and an annual update to the LCAP are not required for the 2020–21 school year.
- SB 98 supersedes the requirement to develop and adopt an LCAP by December 15, 2020, which was established by Executive Order N-56-20, which was published in April 2020.
- The Budget Overview for Parents is separated from the development and adoption of the LCAP for the 2020–21 school year, but still requires development and adoption by December 15, 2020.
- SB 98 establishes California *EC* Section 43509 and the **Learning Continuity and Attendance Plan (Learning Continuity Plan)** requirements for the 2020–21 school year.



Learning Continuity and Attendance Plan

Requirements for adoption of the Plan:

- The Plan must be completed using the template provided by the California Department of Education (CDE) on July 31, 2020
- The local education agency (LEA) governing board must adopt the Plan by September 30, 2020 in a public meeting
- The Plan must be presented at a public hearing prior to, but not on the same day, as the Plan adoption
- Within five days of adopting the Plan, an LEA must file the Plan to the designated reviewing entity, which may review and submit written recommendations for amendments to a Plan by October 30, 2020
- The adopted Plan must be posted on the LEA's website



Learning Continuity and Attendance Plan

The Plan template *memorializes the planning process already underway for the 2020-21 school year* and includes descriptions of:

- In-person instructional offerings
- Distance learning program
- Continuity of instruction
- Pupil participation and progress
- Distance learning professional development
- Staff roles and responsibilities
- Support for pupils with unique needs
- Addressing pupil learning loss due to COVID-19
- Monitoring and supporting mental health and well-being of pupils
- Pupil engagement and outreach
- School nutrition
- Increased or improved services for low income students, English learners, and foster youth



Learning Continuity and Attendance Plan

In developing the Plan, an LEA must consult designated stakeholders, including:

- Teachers
- Principals
- Administrators
- Other school personnel
- Local bargaining units
- Parents
- Students
- Solicit recommendations and comments from the public

Required stakeholder engagement also includes:

- An LEA must present its Plan to its parent advisory committee and English learner advisory committee for review and comment
- The LEA's superintendent must respond in writing to comments received

September, 2020	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Present Plan to DAC and DELAC for their review and comment, and for Superintendent’s response in writing
September 10, 2020	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Present Plan at a public hearing for review and comment by members of the public, including options for remote participation
September 24, 2020	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - HLPUSD Board of Education Meeting for adoption of the Plan
September 29, 2020	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - File the Plan with approving entity (LACOE) not later than 5 days after adoption
December 10, 2020	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - HLPUSD Board of Education Meeting for adoption of the Budget Overview for Parents
